ACADEMIC PLANS:

- a. Starting of PG Courses in Physics, Life Sciences and Chemistry;
- b. Opening of Major Programmes in Education, Hindi, History and Geography;
- c. Starting of Vocational/Add-on certificate/ diploma courses keeping in view locational advantage, faculty expertise and societal/national need such as Tourism and Hospitality Management, Small Tea Garden Management, Wild Life Conservation Biology, Human Rights Education, Mushroom Farming, Dramatics Society etc;
- d. Opening of Skill courses in Computer Hardware and Networking, PGDCA, DCA, Communication Skills, Teaching in Elementary Level, NSS activities;
- e. Developing of e-content and making it accessible for the learners;
- f. Opening of Certificate Program for development of students' moral values such as Yoga and Meditation;
- g. Effective implementation of Mentoring;
- h. Remedial/tutorial coaching for slow learners;
- i. Career counseling / Coaching for entry into services & higher studies for advanced learners;
- j. Use of blended mode for Teaching-learning exercises;
- k. Focus on experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies;
- 1. Developing smart classroom and enhancing use of ICT;
- m. Maintaining a transparent, time- bound and efficient grievances redressal mechanism relating to Curriculum, Teaching –learning and evaluation.
