Specific facilities for women:

➤ **Infrastructural facilities:**

- a) **Common rooms:** Girls' Common Room along with changing room;
- b) Separate Wash rooms for girls with running water;
- c) Separate Wash rooms for Lady teachers with running water;
- d) Incinerator and sanitary napkins vending machine at Girls Common Room;
- e) Incinerator for sanitary waste disposal in the teachers' common room for the lady teachers.

➤ **Gender sensitization/Counseling program:** There is provision for gender sensitization and counseling programme for both girls and boys and these are conducted by Digboi College Women Welfare Cell (DCWWC).

Activities during 2021:

- The Digboi College Women Welfare Cell (DCWWC) conducted a counseling programme for 5th semester girl students of the college on 22nd November, 2021 at college auditorium. The girl students of 5th semester comprising of arts, science and commerce stream of the college shared their problems & experiences with their teacher mentors viz., Dr. Rashmi Patowary & Mrs. Jonali Dutta. Near about 50 students along with DCWWC members participated in the programme. The students mostly came up with the problems of sexual harassment at home and in the streets. The mentors provided emotional encouragement and motivation to the students and assured them all possible help during challenging times.
- On the occasion of International Women's Day a popular talk was delivered by Dr. Seema Roy Kurmi on "Women in leadership: achieving an equal future in a covid-19 world."

➤ **Security and Safety Provisions:**

- **CCTV surveillance of the classrooms.**
- **Training /Workshop for women's safety.**

Activities during 2021:

International Women's Day was celebrated with a 3 day-workshop on self-defense organised by NSS from 6th to 8th March 2021. Pramod Bhuyan, a karate blackbelt holder, shared his expertise in the programme on women's self defense. The workshop was conducted to make them able to protect themselves against unacceptable social conduct.

➤ **Gender equity measure: Program for Women's Economic development:**

Activities during 2021:

- The women of the adopted village Saraipung were trained with Vermi-compost production techniques and a product named as “Patkai Vermi” is produced.
- On 6th of Jan 2021, a training program on silkworm rearing practice was conducted targeting the women of the village Saraipung with a view to bring financial security for the women.
- One day workshop on “Cost effective culture of indigenous *magur* to boost rural economy” at Saraipung.

➤ **Gender equity through equal responsibility:**

- During Covid-19 pandemic period along with male volunteers, female volunteers are also involved in Vaccination drive with all Covid safety measures.

➤ **Any other relevant information:**

- The women of the adopted village Saraipung were trained in Vermicompost production techniques. Department of Zoology of Digboi College, in collaboration with NSS initiated economic boosting techniques through community participation by generating the livelihood skills involving zero cost investments for vermicomposting. A training programme on Vermi compost was organized for the villagers of Saraipung village and 9 nos of Vermi Bed were distributed by District Administration Dibrugarh in collaboration with NSS Digboi College unit, Digboi Forest Division, District Agriculture Department, UNICEF and ABITA on 09/09/2021.
- Local villagers are involved in this practice and 10 vermi-composting units under the product name “Patkai Vermi” are developed.
- On 6th January 2021, a training program on silkworm rearing practice was conducted targeting the women of the village Saraipung which has future scope for financial security. The training was given by Mr. Naba Kochari, Manager of Eri Silk Grainage, Tingrai, Assam.
- One day workshop on “Cost effective culture of indigenous *magur* to boost rural economy” was conducted in Saraipung Village by Dr. Anurag Pratim Dutta, Proprieter of Aqua Paradise, Dibrugarh on 24/11/2021 to train the villagers in *Magur* fish cultivation technique which has potentiality to boost their livelihood.
