II. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- a) Candidates aspiring for Admission into First Semester of three years B.A./B.Sc./B.Com (Honours) programme of Digboi College are required to login to the college website www.digboicollege.edu.in
- b) The candidate shall be required to register in the **ONLINE ADMISSION PORTAL** by entering FULL NAME, USERNAME, PASSWORD AND A MOBILE NUMBER to login. He/She will get an "Activation Code" in the registered Mobile Number which is to be entered for Activation.
- c) After Activation, the candidate shall be required to log in with his/ her user name and password and shall be required to fill up the Online Application Form with correct and appropriate information.
- d) The candidate shall be required to select the required **PROGRAMME** and **STREAM** from the drop downmenu.
- e) The applicant can save and review the information entered before **SUBMISSION**, which can be edited on subsequent logins. However, after submission, editing of information shall not be possible.
- f) On submission of the Online Application Form by an applicant, an AcknowledgementSlip and an Application Form with Unique ApplicantNoshall be generated against each successful submission of the Application. The Candidate shall have to take a print out of both for future reference/verification.
- g) The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.
- h) Admission will be made according to the norms laid down by the Admission Committees on the basis of merit, government-prescribed reservation procedure and availability of seats.
- i) Provisional selection list will be notified in the college website. The provisionally selected applicants will receive message and link in the registered mobile number/email/registered account for CONFIRMING his/her admission.
- j) The provisionally selected applicants must submit **DECLARATION**and **UNDERTAKING**duly signed by him/her and parent in prescribed format (attached with the online admission form) for **confirming**his/her admission in his/her **registered account** in**Online Admission Portal**.
- k) Admission of the provisionally admitted students who misrepresent vital data in respect of their eligibility and admission and those who fail to produce original documents in due course (i.e. during normal class days) shall be cancelled and no prayer shall be entertained.

There shall be no alternative procedure for Application for Admission into Digboi College for the session 2022-23 and the College shall not receive any Application except through the procedure mentioned above



III. Mandatory Documents to be uploaded with the Online Admission form

The following Documents in jpg format must be uploaded online during fill up of Admission form:

- 1) Scanned copy of Recent Passport size of the student
- 2) Scanned signature of the student
- 3) Scanned signature of the parent of the student
- 4) Scanned copy of Mark sheet of last examination passed
- 5) Scanned copy of Pass certificate from the institution last attended
- 6) Scanned copy of Age proof certificate (Birth Certificate / Admit Card)
- 7) Scanned copy of Migration certificate or Transfer certificate if necessary
- 8) Scanned copy of Caste Certificate (OBC/MOBC/ST/SC) if necessary
- 9) Scanned copy of Gap period certificate, if necessary

N.B: The provisionally selected students will have to produce the Originals and photocopies of all relevant documents during the time of Admission.

IV. College Codes specifying Uniform and ID cards:

A. College Uniform:

1. Uniform for Girls:

- Muga or muga coloured Mekhela, white Chadar with sky blue border and white blouse, black pump shoes, or,
- white *saree* with sky blue border and white blouse & black pump shoes, or, sky blue *kameez*, white *salwar*, white *dopatta*, black pump shoes (leggings not allowed).

2. Uniform for boys:

Black formal pants, white shirt (black belt, if used), Black shoes.

3. Additional uniform for winter season:

For Girls: Black cardigan/ Black woollen blouse

For Boys: Black sweater (V-neck)

B. Identity Card:

Every student is issued an Identity Card valid for one year only. In case of loss, a duplicate identity card is issued based on application and payment of Rs. 100.00.

NB:

- Wearing of college uniform with ID card properly displayed during the session is mandatory for each student. No student will be allowed to enter within the college campus without his/ her identity card properly displayed.
- Uniforms made of jeans are not allowed.
