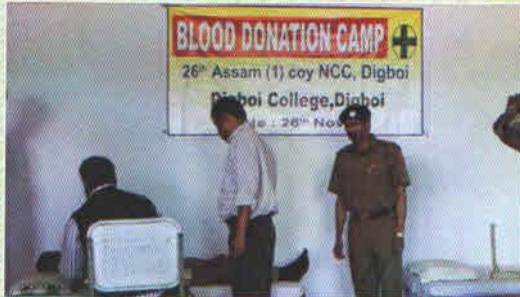
The college fraternity expresses deepest condolences and prays for eternal bliss on the departed souls :
