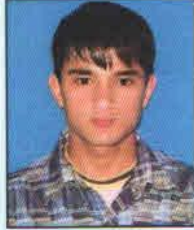

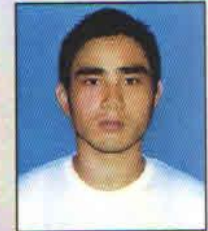

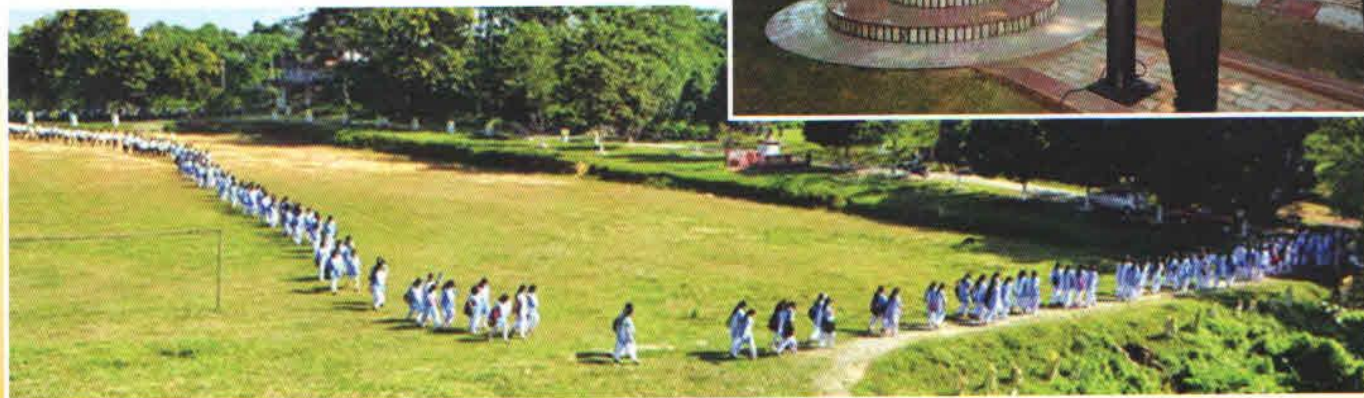
Popular Talk On Wildlife Conservation With Reference To Laboratory For Conservation Of Endangered Species

SPECIAL SESSION OF DCTU STUDY CIRCLE:

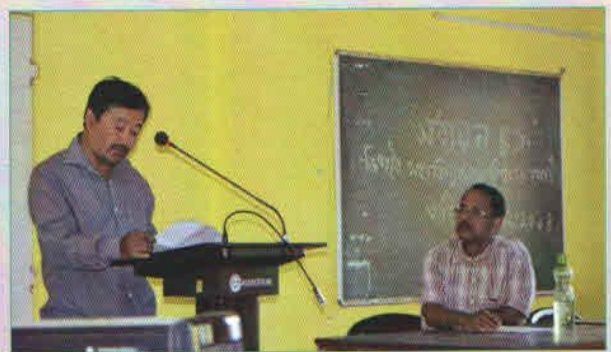
