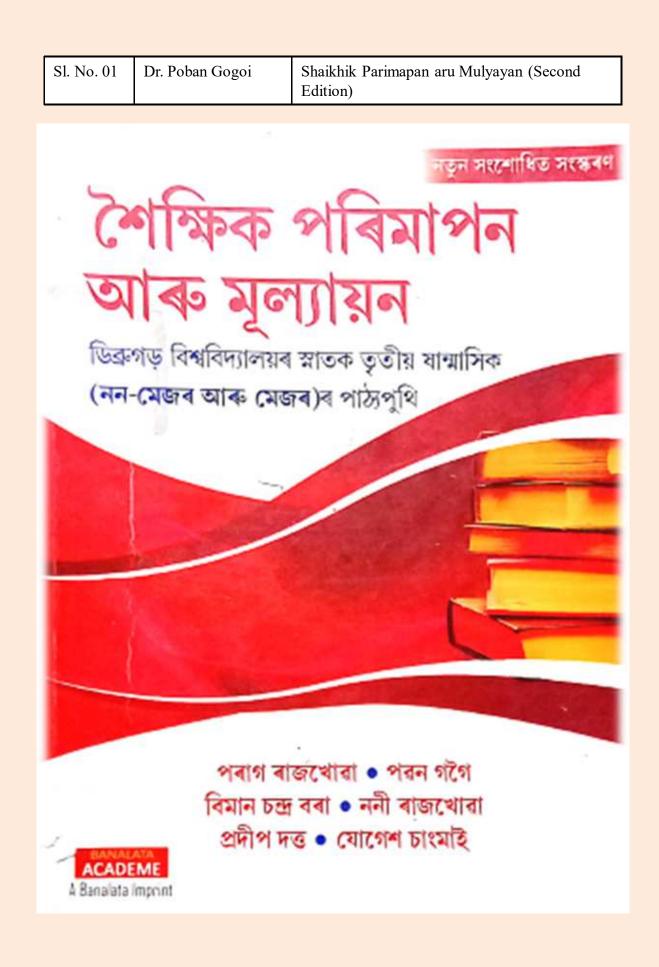

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Chemical Reaction, Heat and Mass Transfer on Unsteady MHD Flow along a Vertical Stretching Sheet with Heat Generation/Absorption and Variable Viscosity

Abstract

The effect of chemical reaction on laminar mixed convection flow and heat and mass transfer along a vertical unsteady stretching sheet is investigated, in the presence of heat generation/absorption with variable viscosity and viscous dissipation. The governing nonlinear partial differential equations are reduced to ordinary differential equations using similarity transformation and solved numerically using the fourth order Runge-Kutta method along with shooting technique. The effects of various flow parameters on the velocity, temperature and concentration distributions are analyzed and presented graphically. Skinfriction coefficient, Nusselt number and Sherwood number are derived at the sheet.

Introduction

Processes involving magnetohydrodynamics(MHD) heat and mass transfer flow in the boundary layer, induced by a moving surface in a fluid with chemical reaction occur frequently in nature. It occurs not only due to temperature difference but also due to magnetic field or combination of these. In chemical engineering there are many transport processes that are governed by the joint action of the buoyancy forces from both thermal and mass diffusion in the presence of chemical reaction effects. During a chemical reaction between two species heat is also generated. Diffusion and chemical reactions in an isothermal laminar flow along a soluble flat plate were studied by Fairbanks and Wike [1]. Chakrabarti and Gupta [2] investigated hydromagnetic flow and heat transfer over stretching sheet. Apelblat[3] presented mass transfer with a chemical reaction of first order with effects of axial diffusion. The effects of mass transfer on flow past an impulsively started infinite vertical plate with constant heat flux and chemical reaction were studied by Das et al.[4].

Anjalidevi and Kandasamy [5] studied the steady laminar flow along a semi-infinite horizontal plate in the presence of a species concentration and chemical reaction. Fan et al. [6] studied the mixed convective heat and mass transfer over a horizontal moving plate with a chemical-reaction effect. Takhar et al. [7] investigated the flow and mass diffusion of a chemical species with first-order and higher order reactions over a continuously stretching

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An Empirical Evaluation of Top Indian Journals

Deepjyoti Kalita* and Prafulla Mahanta**

The study explores the top Indian journals based on the Scimago Journal Rank (SJR) indicator used in Scopus database. The freely accessible portal Scimago Journal & Country Rank website was used for collecting data about the top journals based on their SJR value. 2014 was selected as base year for completing citation data about the journals. Forty (40) of the top fifty (50) Indian journals are found to be open access journals that reflect the growing popularity and quality of Indian open access journals. Evaluation of quartile ranking showed 58% of top journals in the Q2 of respective subject disciplines, while subject analysis of the journals found 37% of the journals belonging to the discipline of Medicine. The feature of 24 journals in the top 50 list makes Medknow Publications the most impactful publishing house in India, followed by the Indian Academy of Sciences with 5 journals. All featured journals from Medknow Publications and Indian Academy of Sciences are open access journals.

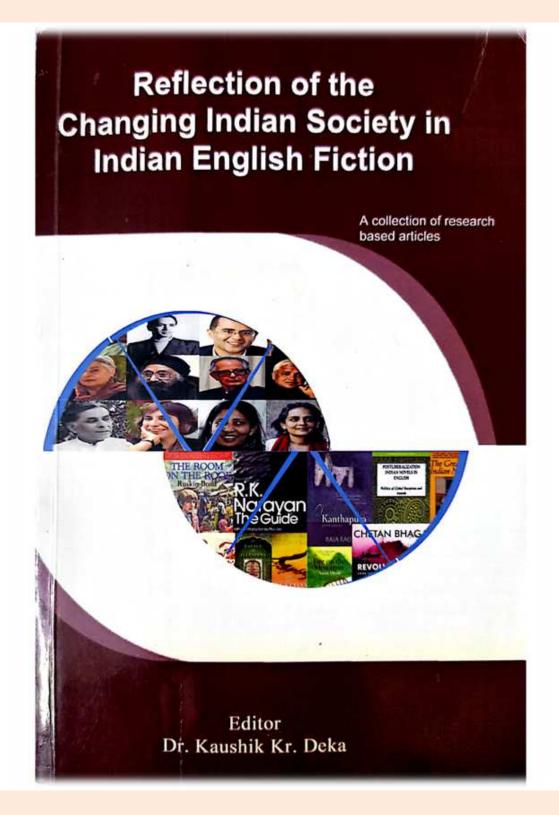

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WOMEN AS MARKERS OF SOCIAL CHANGE WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO R.K. NARAYAN'S-'THE GUIDE'

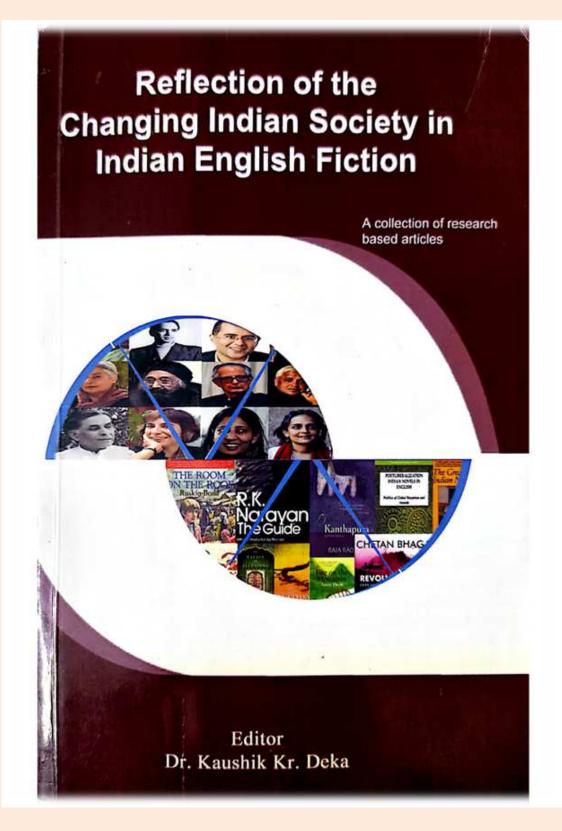
In this paper I propose to look at Narayan's Malgudi as a mirror social change, particularly in South India, during this time. My focus will be on their presentation of women characters, many of whom are depicted by R.K. Narayan as crucial markers of change in a 'modernizing' world.

Narayan's women characters stand both for change, and for resistance to change. The struggle by society to accept new modes of living being are presented very subtly and delicately, by a series of external contrasts and counterpoints between the older and the youngest women, between different class values, and between outsiders and newcomers and local Malgudi people. It is also presented through a series of symbols which reflect or suggest the inner conflicts of the women protagonists themselves, who, although they are marker of change, are at the same time aware of devastation such a change might bring.

If Narayan is pessimistic about change occurring within the frame work of the orthodox middle class family, he is certainly able to see change coming from elsewhere. To this end, he continues to develop his studies of women who may be the objects of love/attachment, but outside the context of marriage; whose position is ambiguous in regard to society, towards kinship ties and towards their own careers. On the one hand, they have pulled free from caste/class bonds, sometimes through fortuitous circumstances, in a way that Savitri could not hope to be.

Again, although sometimes in his novels, two different sets of roles('traditional'/'modern') are available to two different sets of women, the most interesting of Narayan's women characters contain the polarity within themselves: their struggle for self-definition is often through a struggle to resolve this polarity. The complexity of Rosie/Nalini, possibly the most fully

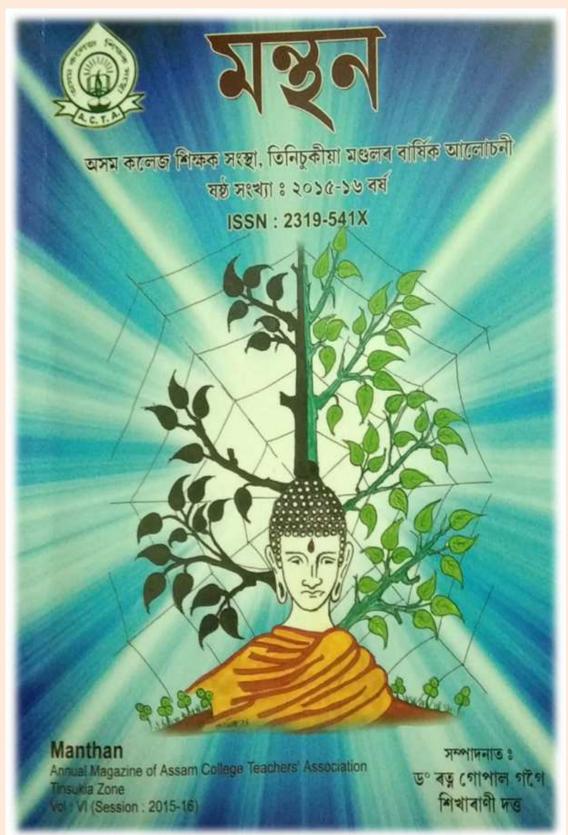

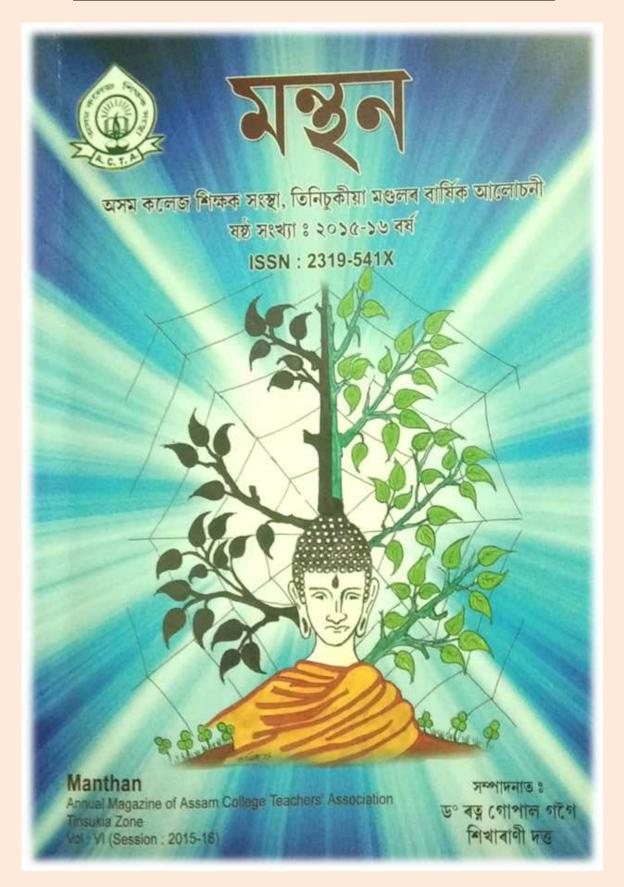

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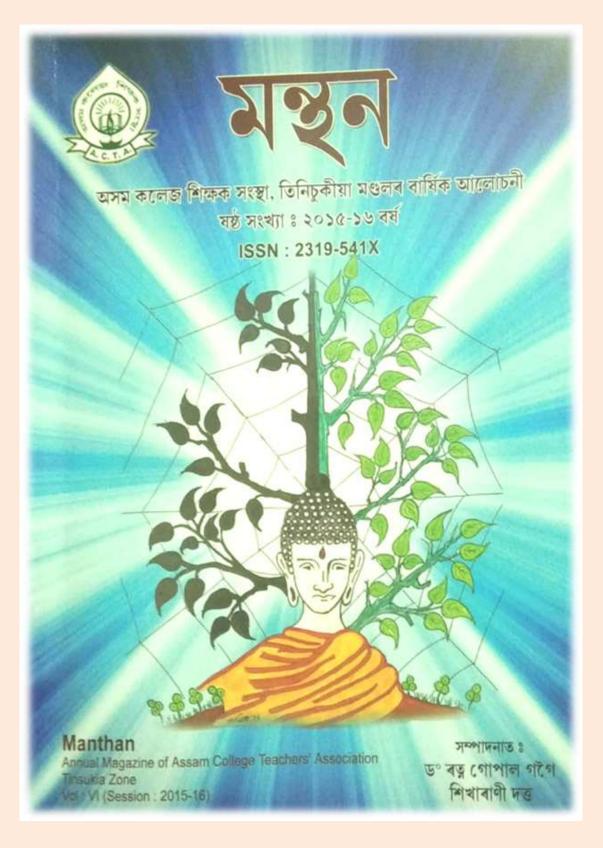

Introduction : Srimanta Sankaradeva was a great saint, scholar, poet, playwright and socio- religious reformer of Assam. Born on the last day of 'Ahin' month, during the autumn of 1449 A.D., at Alipukhuri of Nagaon district of Assam, he had immortal influence in the cultural, religious and ideological lives of Assamese people. Legend says that when Sankardeva was born, the conches, bells and drums etc. started ringing themselves in the nearby temples. Although it may be due to the devastating earthquake that shook the entire valley right at that moment, yet it also represents symbolically the fact that a new era was started with the arrival of Srimanta Sankaradeva. He tried to lift the people of Assam in all possible dimensions by spreading a moderate and egalitarian philosophy among the people.

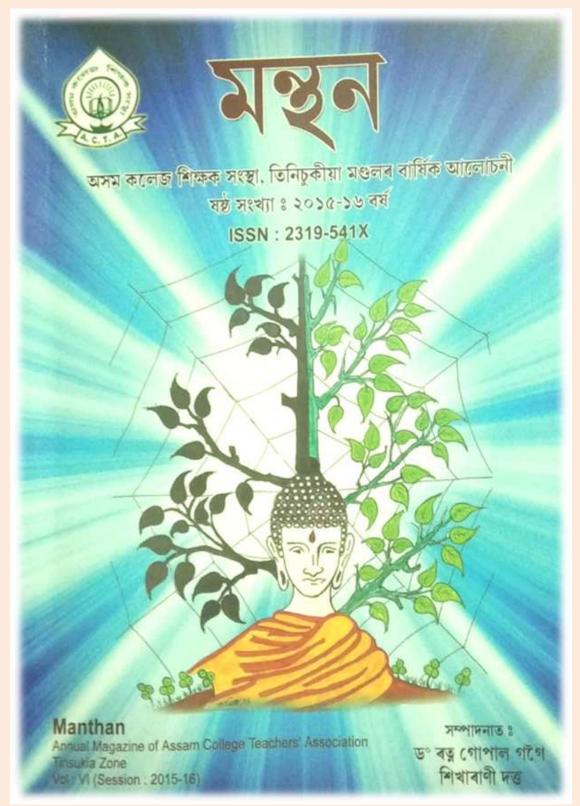
Whether Sankaradeva can be considered as a philosopher or not is a controversial question. He did not formulate any systematic philosophy like that of a technical philosopher, nor did he present any specific philosophy about the nature of ultimate reality or about the origin of the world. In fact, he was not interested in metaphysical speculations. Rather his approach was faith oriented and was more concerned with existential problems of life. Problems of God, self, and liberation etc. found more importance in his philosophy. He talked about God and spoke about the importance of devotion in realizing God. He was greatly influenced by the philosophical teachings of the Upanishads, and the Puranas. He tried to reveal them through his writings.

Abstract:

The 'Trishanku location' as appropriated in Diaspora studies signifies the 'in-between position', one's sense of oscillation between nations and cultures, as well as the 'third space' where people acquire a hybrid and transnational identity. Uma Parameswaran draws an analogy between Trihanku's heaven and the diasporic position. With the concern of Diaspora studies for 'in-betweenness' and 'hybridity' experienced by diasporic persons, Trishanku has become a metaphor for diasporic position. In the fictional memoir Running in the Family (1982) Michael Ondaatje's Trishanku experience is delineated through his oscillating senses of belonging to homeland. The author's settlement in Canada against his attempt of re-rooting in Sri Lanka is presented in the memoir. In Anil's Ghost, the involvement of Anil in investigating 'extrajudicial execution' of her native country on the one hand and the circumstances that force her to leave Sri Lanka depicts a Trishanku situation. With the dual and oscillating sense of belonging to both home and host nations/cultures and being products of the east and the west, Ondaatje as well as his fictional self achieve hybridity and transnationality with their relocation in Trishanku's heaven.

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Situating 'Trishanku': Hybridity and Transnationality in Michael **Ondaatje's Fiction**

The 'Trishanku location' as appropriated in Diaspora studies signifies the 'in-between position', one's sense of oscillation between nations and cultures, as well as the 'third space' where people acquire a hybrid and transnational identity. The term 'Trishanku' originates from the Hindu myth of Trishanku's heaven that relates the story of the creation of a new heaven by the great Sage Viswamitra for the mortal king Trishanku who the sage sent to heaven alive but who being denied the entry, came downward to earth. The sage stopped Trishanku midway and created some heavenly bodies amidst which Trishanku ruled as a king with his posture upside down. The king in the myth lived between heaven and earth. In this way, Trishanku's location refers to a place which is neither 'here' nor 'there', but 'inbetween". Uma Parameswaran in Trishanku and other poems while expressing the immigrant experience of rootlessness and search for identity draws an analogy between Trihanku's heaven and the diasporic position. With the concern of Diaspora studies for 'in-betweenness', 'hybridity' and the homely houselessness/homelessly housed situations experienced by diasporic persons, Trishanku has become a metaphor for diasporic position. The present paper is an attempt to elucidate the Trishanku position of the Booker winner Michael Ondaatje, the Sri Lankan-Canadian diasporic writer and his characters as delineated in his fictional works Running in the Family (1982) and Anil's Ghost (2000).

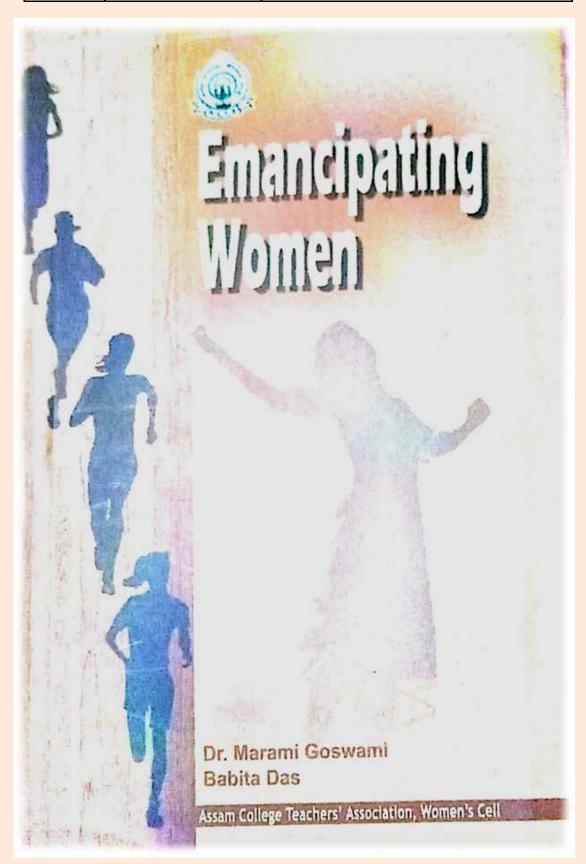
To begin with, the Trishanku location succinctly signifies the position of a wish fulfilled but desires unsatisfied. This is a situation faced by the immigrants as they are forced to straddle two societies, two cultures and two entirely different new worlds. The diasporic people often experience a situation of 'exile', 'unhoused' and 'decentred' (Said Culture 403). The position of the diasporic individual can be said to be a hybrid one since, in Bhaba's opinion, hybridization is the emergence of new cultural forms from multiculturalism. Bhabha observes that colonial histories and cultures constantly intrude on the present, thereby lead to the formation of new identities. Bhaba challenges the essentialist construction of identity as a 'finished product' (Bhaba 73), highlights the hybrid identity of the diaspora and observes that identity of the diaspora can be situated in the 'in-between' spaces that initiate 'new signs of identity' (Bhaba 2). This state of fluidity forms the core of diasporic identity since displacement and dislocation of the individual often result in the loss of original identity and the formation of a new identity as well. Bhabha posits hybridity as a form of liminal or inbetween space, where the 'cutting edge of translation and negotiation' occurs and which he terms the third space. (Rutherford 221). 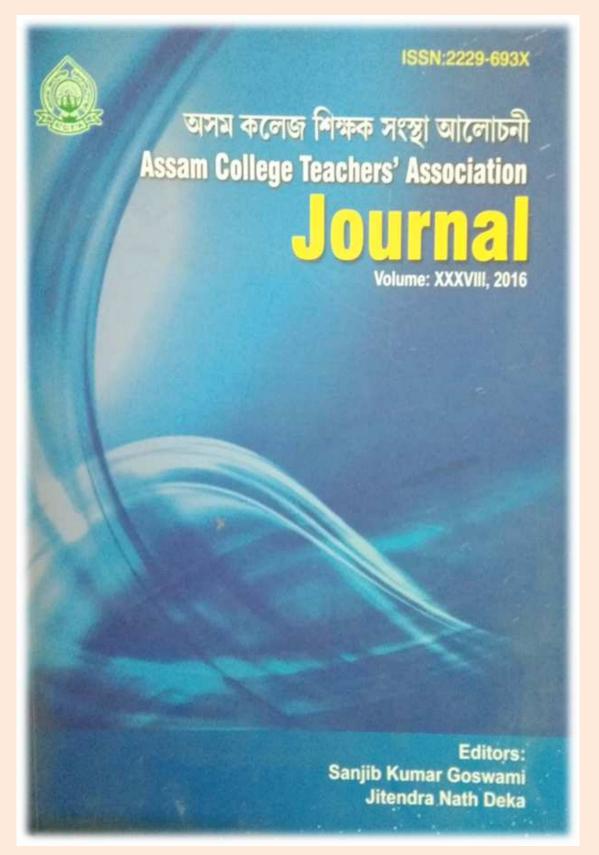

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A Study of Attitude among the Degree Level Students of Digboi Towards Mobile Learning

"A Study of Attitude among the Degree Level Students of Digboi towards Mobile Learning" is an attempt to analyze the attitude of degree level students of Digboi area, Tinsukia District, Assam. This micro level study tried to have an insight on attitude towards M-obile Learning (M-Learning). The attempt was also made to analyze the attitude of the degree level students of Digboi area in relation to gender and locality. The Normative survey method was followed for collection of data. The sample consists of 210 degree level students studying in Digboi College and Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya. The sample was selected by using incidental sampling technique. The investigators used the "Attitude Scale towards M-learning" for the purpose which consists of 20 positive items. For analyzing data statistical techniques namely: percentage, mean, standard deviation, 'Z' tests were employed. Degree level students of Digboi were found to have a favourable attitude towards M-Learning. On the other hand; significant differences in attitude were found among degree level students with respect to gender and locality.

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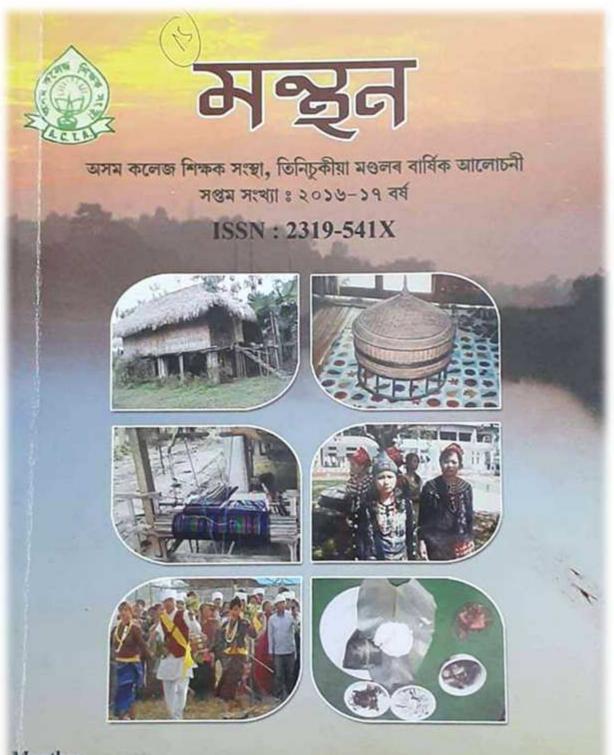
Gunotsav: A Milestone for Celebrating Quality at Elementary Education in Assam

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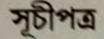

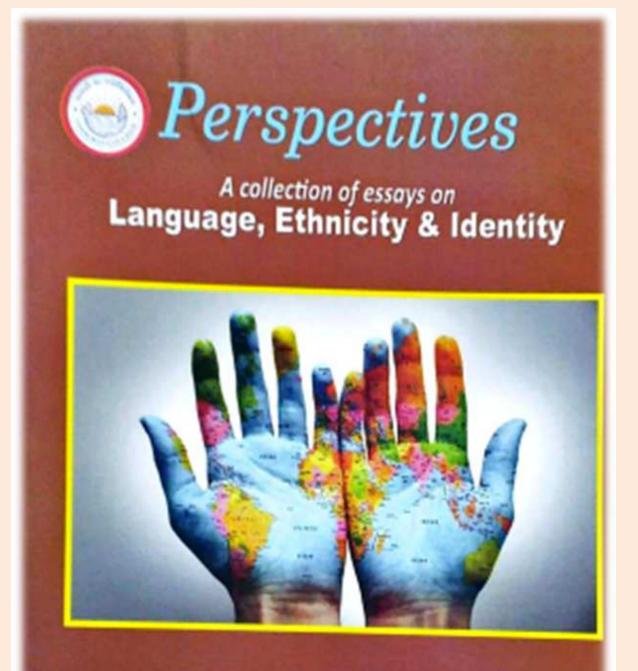

Introduction

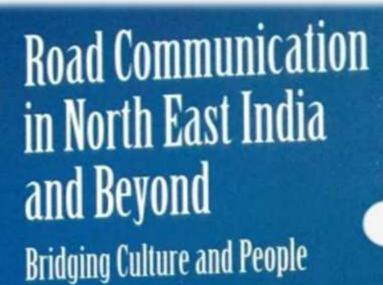
Dispersion of human being is universal phenomenon, but then, it does not signify a material side only. As a cultural product, human beings carry with them the very traits of the original culture into the new land. In the new land, Diasporas are confronted with new culture traits and the experience what Kalervo Oberg (1954) calls 'culture shock', the unexpected and unfavourable difference of culture. Oberg defines culture shock as a series of environment reactions and as the 'anxiety that results from losing all our familiar signs and symbols of social intercourse' (1) He further states that this culture shock affects all those people whom 'suddenly transplanted abroad' (1) With their transplantation abroad, the Diasporashaven interact with the strange people having unfamiliar cultural habits. They carry the cultured their homeland and desperately attempt to continue the same in the foreign land where the hostile society and alien culture clashes with the native culture of the Diasporals As language is one of the significant aspects of culture, a major dimension of culture shock is the shock involving language. The present paper is an attempt to interpret the diverse dimensions of linguistic negotiation by Ondaatje's diasporic protagonists in Running in the Family And Ghost and In the Skin of a Lion.

Analysis

To begin with, dispersed people negotiate language for two purposes - to redain "root" in the original land/culture and assimilate into the host land/culture. With the persisted influence and memory of the homeland and the desire to secure a space in the homeland Diasporas not only inculcate the native language, but also contribute to its richness. Mercand, in order to assimilate into alien land, Diasporas need to learn and practice the foreign language The absence of a common verbal communicative medium adds only to the multiplication of the plight of the Diasporas. Linguistic predicament of Diasporas can be resolved through extensive use of body language that fills up the gap between people of diverse language

Language, then, is a significant way of reclaiming root. Acculturation of native language and use of homeland literary 'modes' point to Diasporas' attachment to the 'root'. Diaspora may revive native language and literature in an attempt to remain connected to the original "home" and culture. Use of indigenous ethnic names, special words of homeland languages and appropriation of native literary practices are various dynamics of linguistic reclamation root. In this connection, Vijay Mishra considers the very act of writing about hencland site signifier of diasporic attachment to home culture. 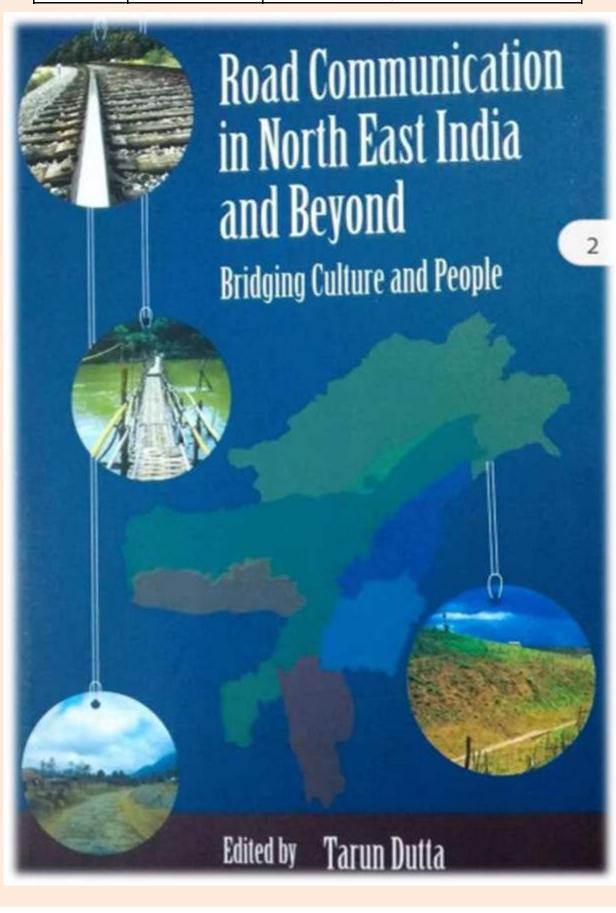
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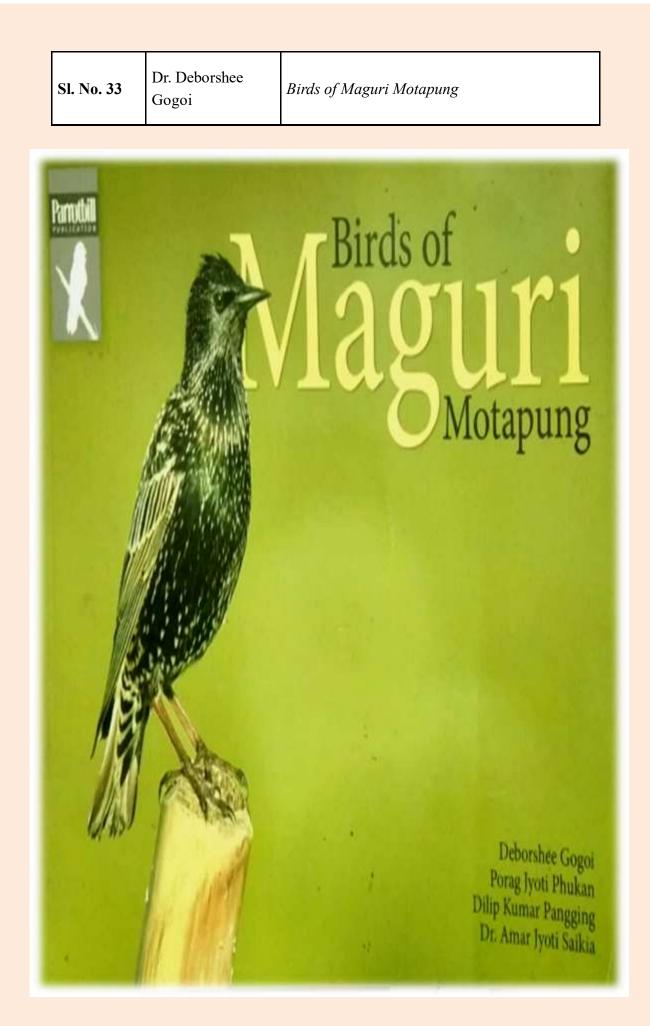
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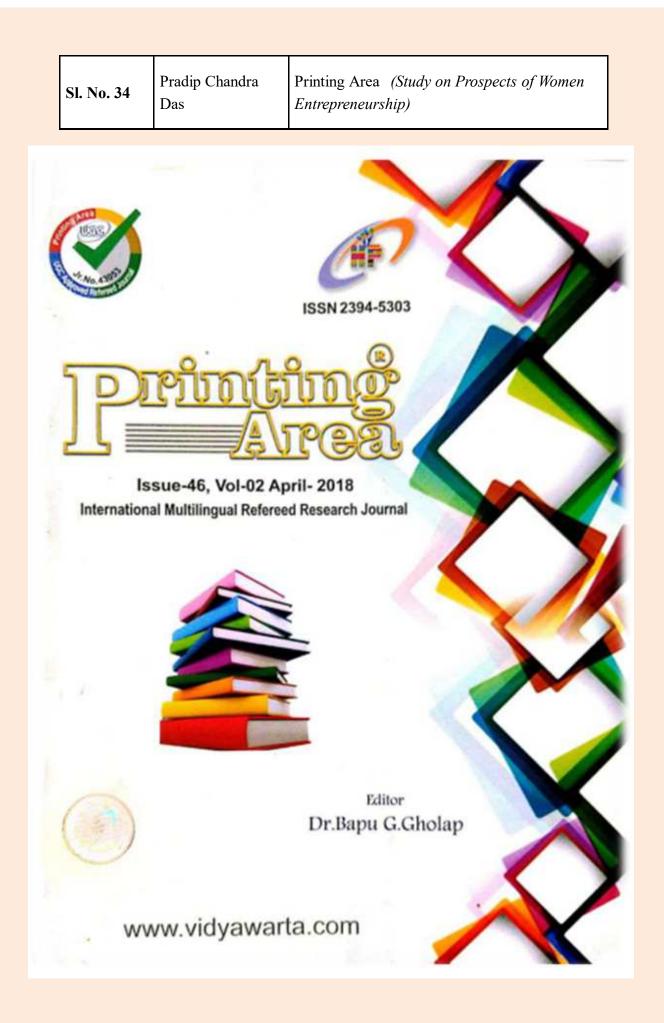
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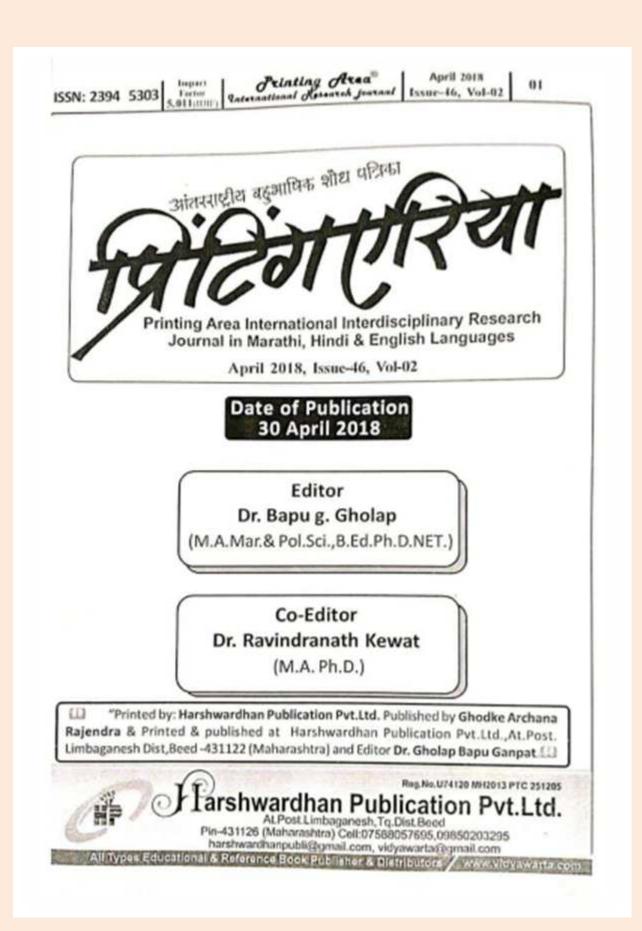
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A STUDY ON PROSPECTS OF WOMEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN TINSUKIA DISTRICT OF ASSAM

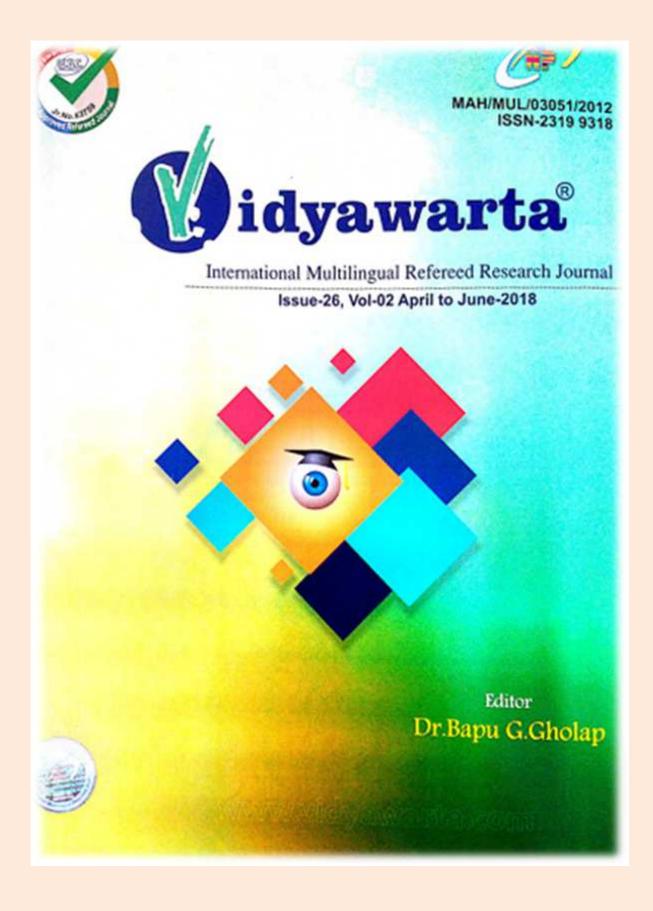

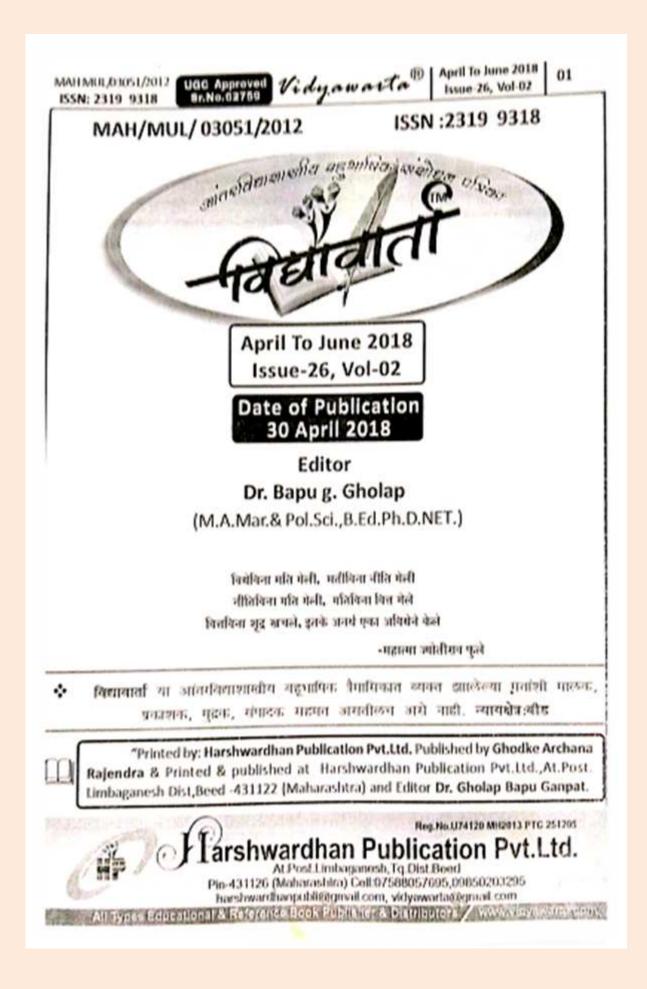
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Role of Indigenous food items during pregnancy with special reference to the tea garden women in the Chandmari Tea Estate of Tinsukia District, Assam

Tea plantation in India is a kind of gift of British Colonial administration. Teals one of the oldest and organized industries in the country. Assam is incidentally the highest producer of tea and its quality is still unmatched to anyone. At present Assam they have a large number of resident population and work force. There are more than 100 tribe and cast groups the compose the tea worker population in Assam. Most of them were brought on contract basis from other states 150 years ago during the initial days of opening up the industry. In course of time these migrant workers have settled here permanently in the tea garden and in nearby rural areas of garden.

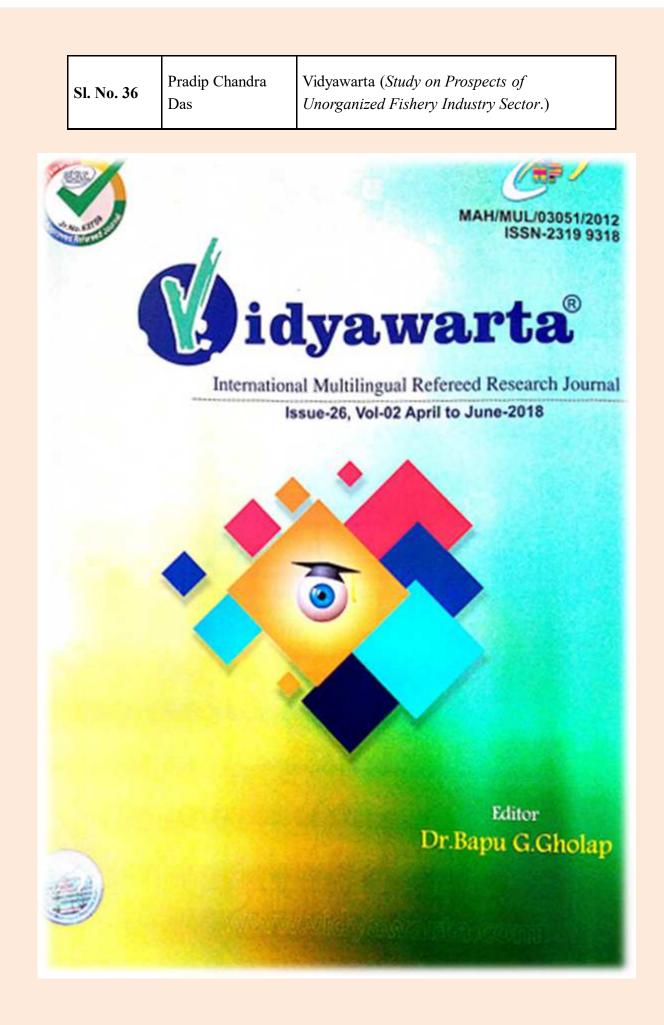
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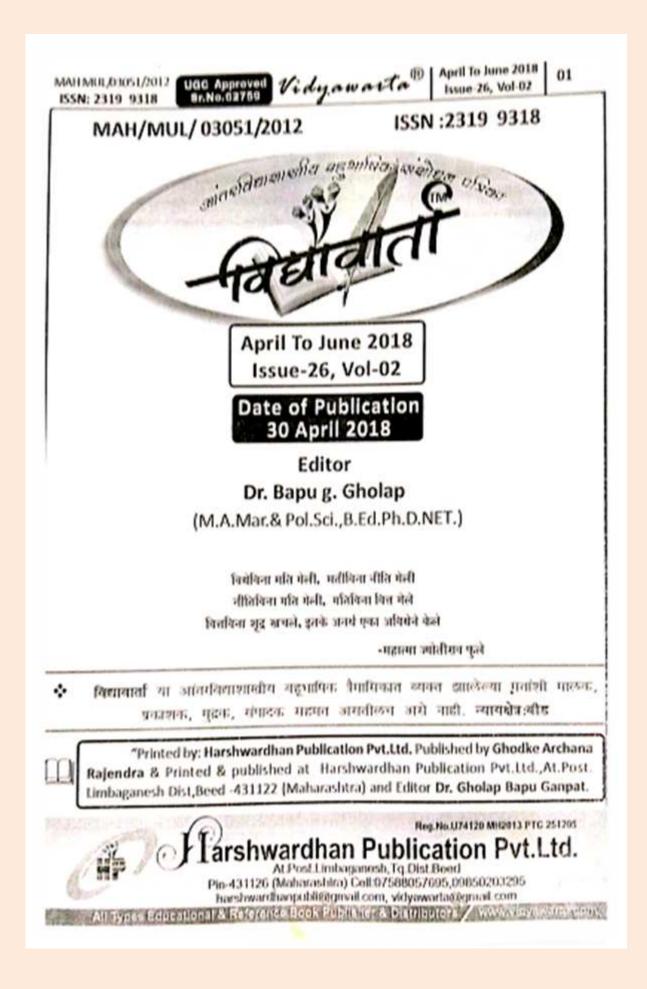

Particularly during pregnancy they don't take any care of promotive health measures. Therefore, they have been found to suffer various diseases like nutritional anemia, eclampsia, gestational diabetes etc. Many of the diseases are resulted out of mainutrition and undernutrition. 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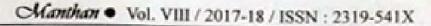
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Exploring 'rootedness': Indianness of Nissim Ezekiel

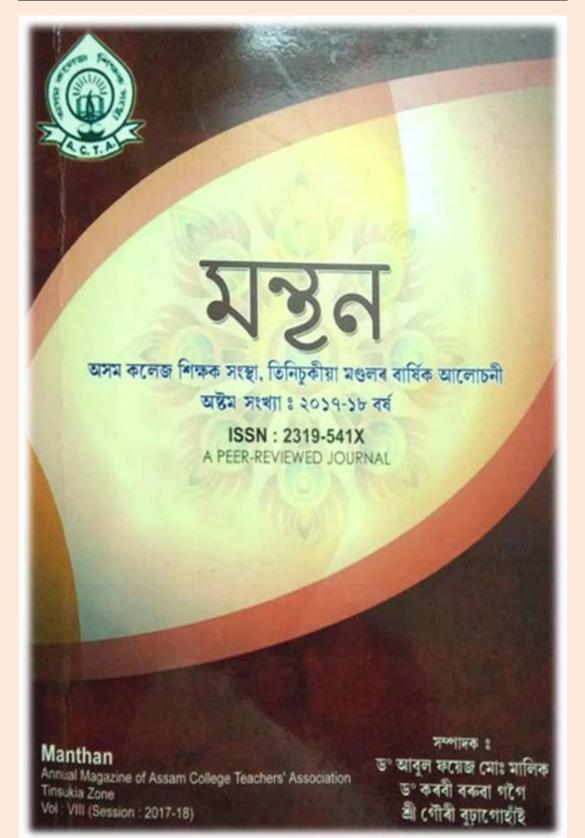
Separation from one's cultural roots is one of the most traumatic experience of any normal human being and it is accentuated if he/she has borne a diasporic history. To overcome the trauma of geographical and cultural distances, the person needs to look for ways to 'belong', 're-root', 'relocate' in the new land and culture although it is greatly problematic since mastering a culture, adopting and adapting them in the compatible way sustains as a case of constant negotiation. 'Belongingness' is a theme that is universally relevant. Everyone comes from somewhere and most people do feel a sense of belonging to some place or other. Though people may not live in their birthplace, they may still have a sense of belonging to it. Again, a person's sense of belonging may change, loyalties may shift, and the original sense of belonging may disappear completely in favour of another. In postcolonial diaspora studies, the issue has invited multiple interrogations and great critical attention. While on the one hand, this sense of belonging, i.e. the diasporic consciousness, leads to the formation of a new community, though imagined, on the other, it reiterates the search for root in the original homeland/culture. Avtar Brah's concept of home as a 'mythic place of desire' is a way of depicting this sense of belongingness to one place/culture. (Brah:192)

Ezekiel's cultural situation makes him a cultural diaspora in India and his condition was much traumatized by the upheavals of the time. He was very much conscious about his Bene-Israeli origin and his Indian context. At a time when Nissim Ezekiel was trying to achieve his poetic distinction and cultural identity, the scenario of India was passing through a very critical situation. The Britishers had already faced the idea of multi-ethnic and multicultural status of India. Moreover, an awareness of Hinduism was trying to seek the image of India within it. At the time of independence of India, there was division of India on the basis of religious considerations and ethnic violence. At that time, there was growing consciousness of Indianism and the Hindu community was trying to hold the real image of India within itself. Other communities could hardly have any share of that great pride of Indianism that was being kept at the time of Independence. The horrible wind of violence had already blown up the sober colours of cultural distinction of the synthesis of multi-ethnic character of India. During his teenage, Nissim Ezekiel had to face the problem of seeking his cultural identity. His Hindu friends extended their favour to him as if it was a part of

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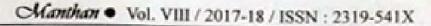
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JOB SATISFACTION OF COLLEGE TEACHERS

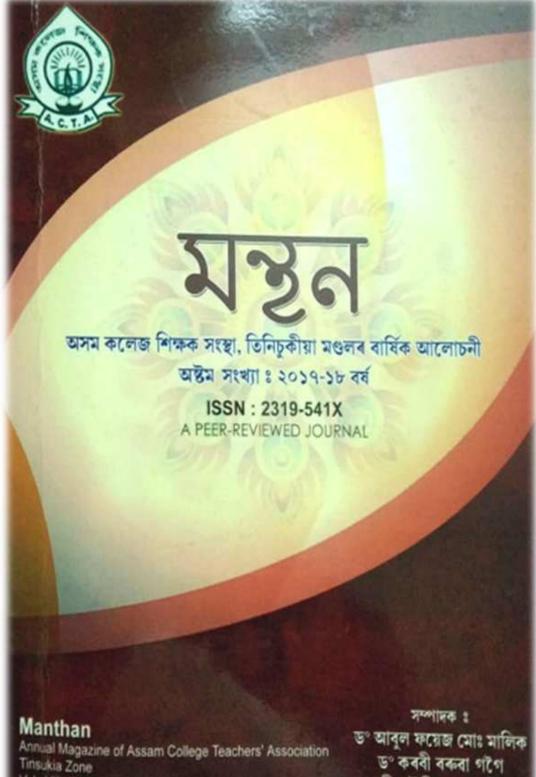
One of the biggest preludes to the study of job satisfaction was the Hawthorne studies (1924–1933). These studies primarily credited to Elton Mayo of the Harvard Business School who sought to find the effects of various conditions (most notably illumination) on workers' productivity. These studies ultimately showed that novel changes in work conditions temporarily increase workers' productivity (called the Hawthorne Effect). It was later found that this increase resulted, not from the new conditions, but from the knowledge of being observed. This finding provided strong evidence that people work for some purposes other than pay, which paved the way for researchers to investigate other factors of job satisfaction. The Hawthorne investigations saw a poor working context is the deterrent for good working practices resulting in the frustration of the employees which leads to low productivity. A developed working context would lead to more productivity. It emphasized the human relation factors such as friendly supervision, rest pauses, hours of work etc. which are crucial for job satisfaction of employees.

Scientific Management (Taylorism) had too a significant impact on the study of job satisfaction. Frederick Winslow Taylor (1911) in his book "Principles of Scientific Management" argued that there was a single best way to perform any given work. This book contributed to a change in industrial production philosophies, causing a shift from skilled labour and piecework towards the more modern of assembly Lines and hourly wages. The initial use of scientific management by industries greatly increased productivity because workers were forced to work at a faster pace. However, workers became exhausted and dissatisfied, thus leaving researchers with new questions to answer regarding job satisfaction. It should also be noted that the work of W.L. Bryan, Walter Dill Scott and Hugo Munsterberg set the tone for Taylor's work. Some argue that Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs theory, a motivation theory, laid the foundation for job satisfaction theory.

The term 'Job' refers to collection of tasks, duties and responsibilities which as a whole is regarded as the established assignments to an individual. It also includes occupational activity performed by individual in return for monetary reward. Satisfaction, on the other hand; means the fulfillment of needs or desires of an individual. Satisfaction is a complex of feelings,

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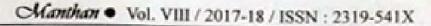
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INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS: THE EMERGING ISSUES IN PRESENT WORLD CONTEXT

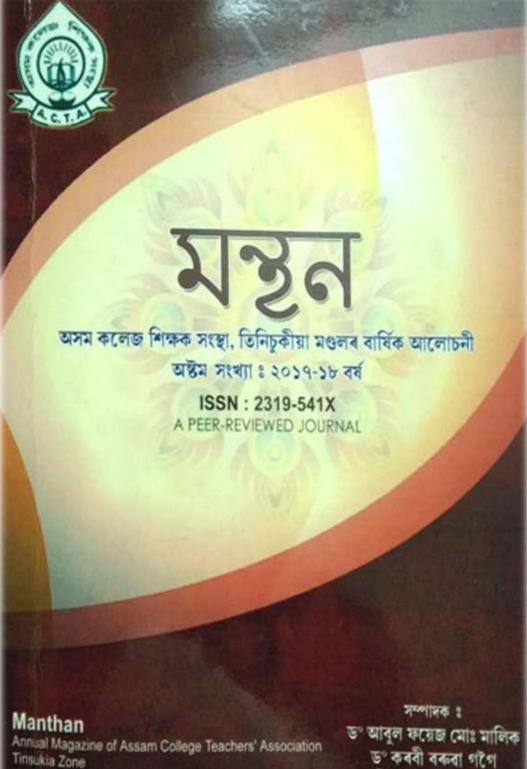

This has attracted calls for a review of some of the IR policies and a discard of others with the aim to streamlining the international relations so as to incorporate the new emerging issues.

According to Jackson and Sorensen (2007), "There are developments that remain as reminders to the fact that the world of states is dynamic, changing world and not static, unchanging one, in that in international relations, just as in other spheres of human relations; nothing stands still for a very long time". The truth of the matter is that international relations change with the every aspect of our lives. These include fundamental factors that play profound influences in our lives such as education, politics, economics, technology and culture.

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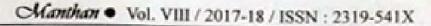
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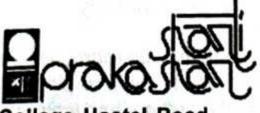

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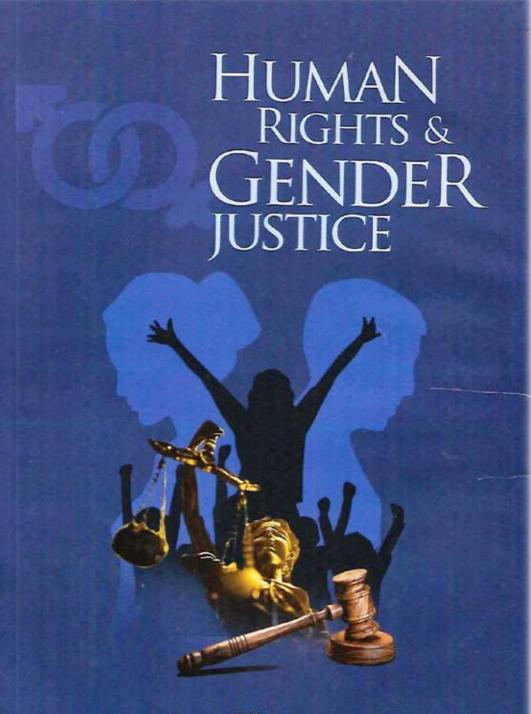
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CHILD LABOUR AND VIOLATION OF CHILD RIGHTS IN DIGBOI TOWN: A STUDY

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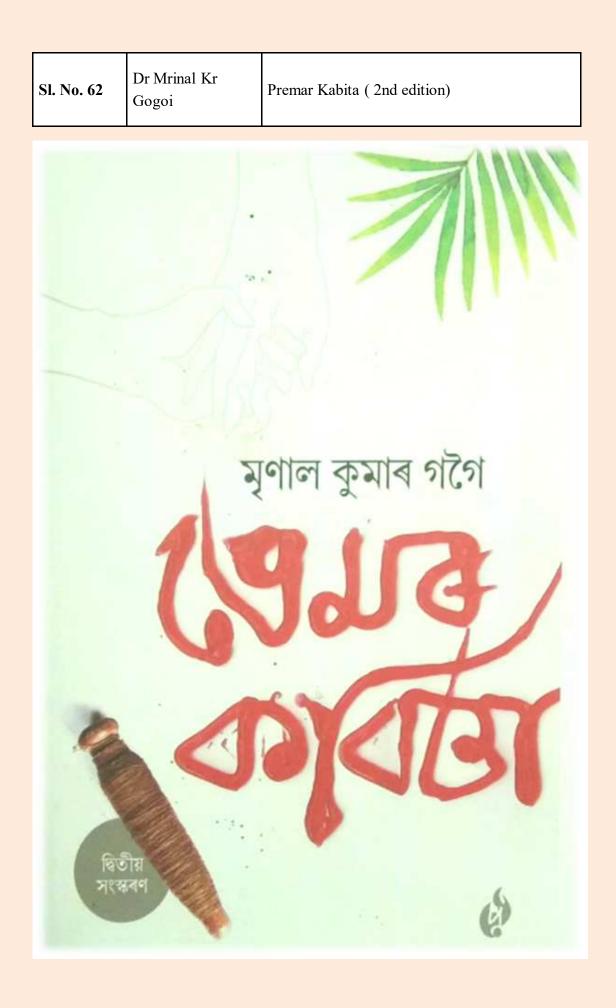

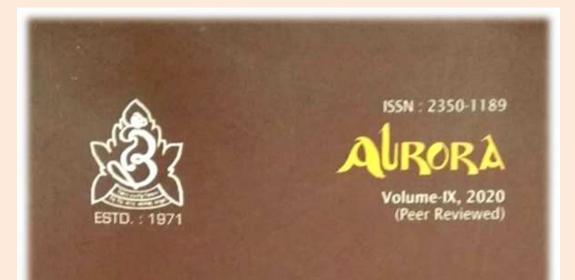

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A STUDY ON PERCEPTION OF GIRL STUDENTS OF DIGBOI COLLEGE ON PROBLEMS OF WOMEN EDUCATION

Abstract

Despite their progress in various fields, women and girls continue to face various barriers based on gender in addition to other related factors like age, ethnicity, poverty, disability etc. Out of the many serious educational problems of women specially in case of Assam; some are - gender stereotypes; gender-based violence; lack of proper physical facilities and poverty. Present study is an attempt to analyse the degree of these four problems of women education; as perceived by the girls students of Digboi College. The main objectives of the present study are- to find out perception of girl students on problems of women education and to compare the perception of rural and urban girl students on problems of women education. The sample for the present study consists of 200 girl students. In the present study the "Scale for Problems of Women Education (SPWE)" is used for collection of data. Majority of the girl students perceive that the problems of women education are not prevalent. Another finding of the study is that there is no significant difference between rural and urban girl students with regard to their perception on problems of women education.

Between his notoriously sketchy treatment of women on set to his depiction of them in his funs, Alfred Hitchcock remains a divisive filmmaker when it comes to women. Hitchcock's greatness lies in the fact that apart from entertaining his audiences, his 'thrillers' often have smething very interesting and thought- provoking to convey – humour, the sense of alienation, a loss of identity, psychological trauma, or the sociological conditions of time. Hitchcock's films have a special appeal for me because they are open to psychoanalytic interpretation. The present paper is a humble attempt to study his films as texts and their relationship(s) with women who form part of the films as well as part of the audience.

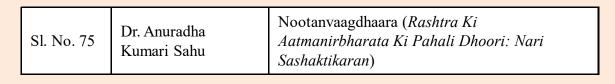
The film noir as a genre originated in inter-war and post world war II Europe and America. Soon it became a conventional medium for expressing the thoughts and emotions of the time. In French Noir means black, hence the black film. If one looks into the films of Alfred Hitchcock one cannot overlook the fact that though they never play the role of 'heroines' (as opposed to heroes) Hitchcock's films would never be the same without them. One cannot deny their presence in the films for they literally have a bearing even from their graves as in the case of Carlotta, Valdz, Mrs Bates, and Rebecca.

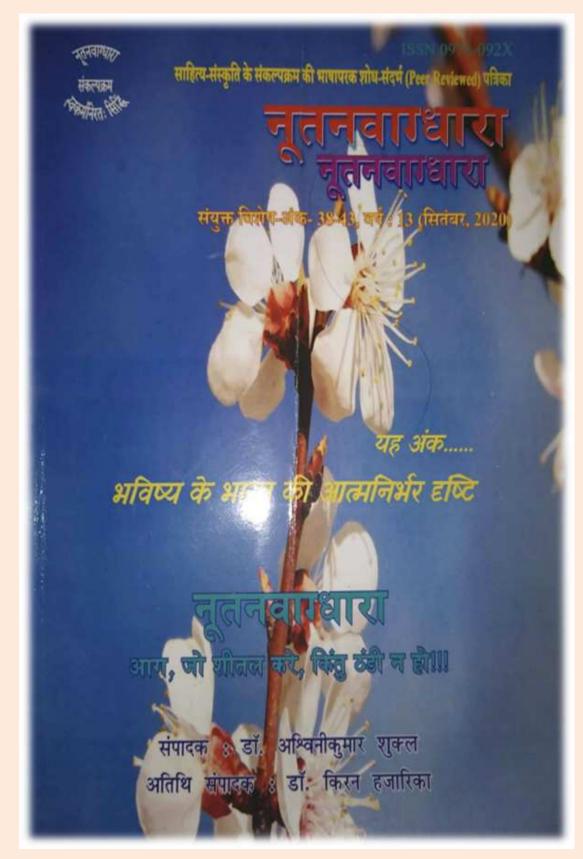
Again, considering the living women in his films, one realizes that they are never really allowed to develop as subjects. That is to say that women are always projected as objects -sexual objects for male gaze. This is achieved by the interaction between the woman (on the screen) with the man / men on the screen; the spectators; and the camera—the instrument of voyeurism—that originally sets the whole activity into motion. So, since the women are seen as objects, they neely become agents in any action. However when they do imitate any action in the film it is due to the 'unavailability' of the hero. This is very much evident in his film Rear Window where when the hero is rendered invalid with a fractured leg the women character Lisa takes on an assignment to go and dig up the suspects backyard and snoop around his flat.

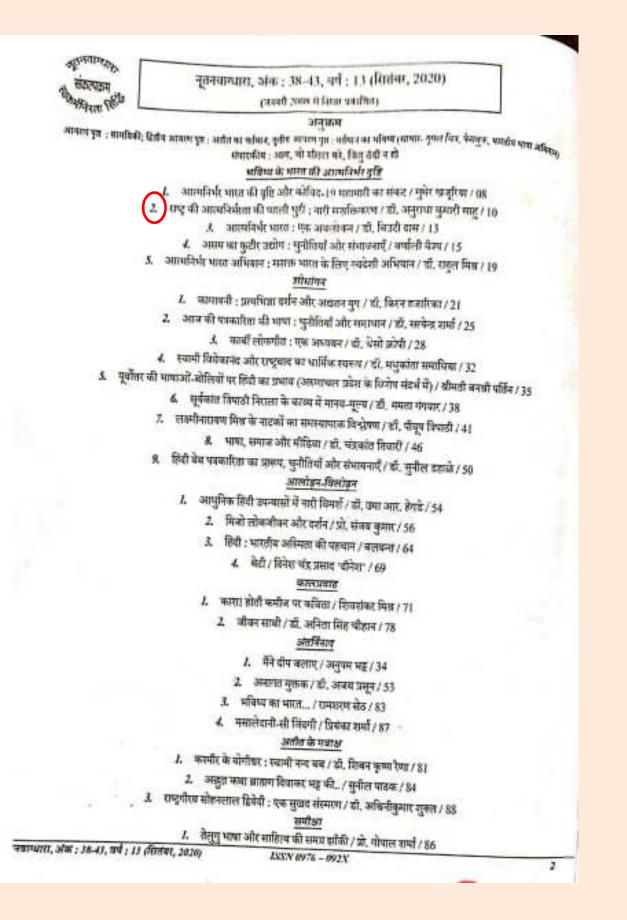
The hero Jeffries, who earlier comments that he wants a woman " who can go anywhere the wants and do anything she wants" is very disturbed by her action because it is not something that a women should do. Another such instances of 'objectification ' of woman is in his portrayal of Alicia(Notorious) and Alice(Blackmail) as sexual entities.

In the films of Hitchcock the presence of female has always been of a kind that would stun be spectators. And it is the beauty of the woman on the screen that the audience notices at the very outset. Hitchcock cast women like Ingrid Bergman, Grace Kelley, Kim Novak and so on as female characters. Woman's sexuality as portrayed in the film becomes a highly potent factor after film, but at the same time they are suppressed as much as possible. The men in the films are at ease in the presence of this exuding female charm. This is nothing extraordinary because

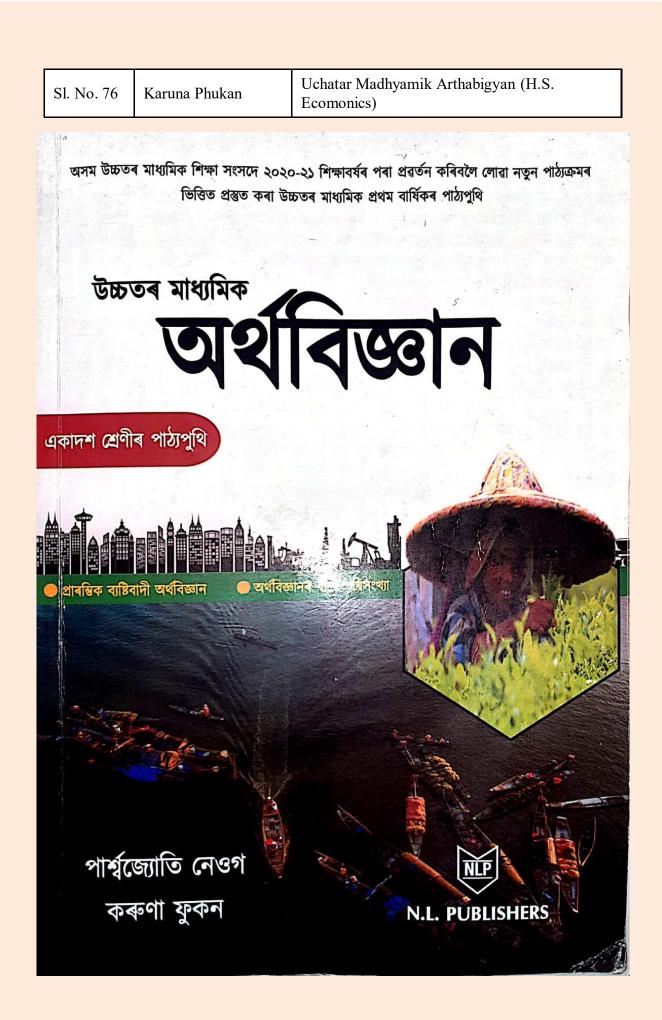

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MODERNISM AND POSTMODERNISM

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Hyper-Reality As a Postmodern Literary Technique

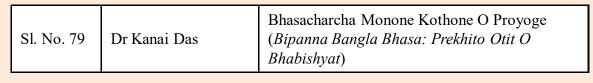
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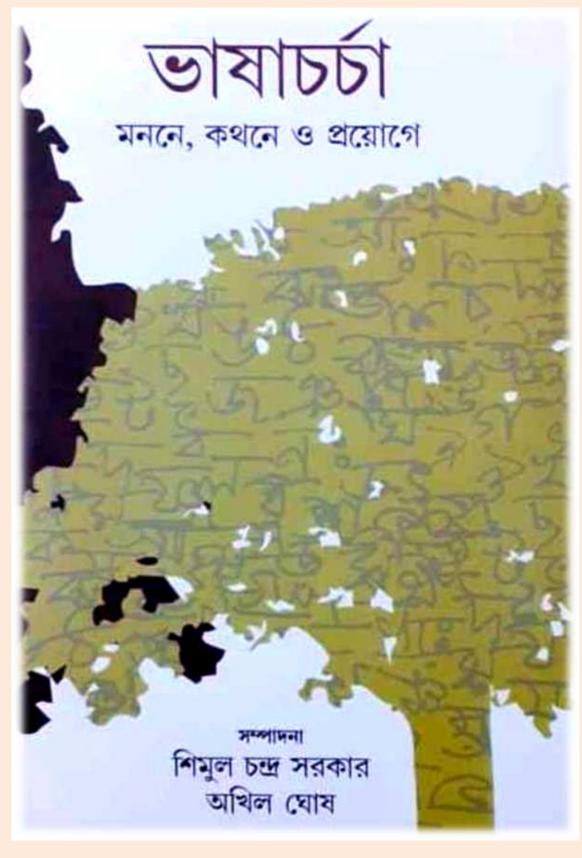
As a reaction to modernist concerns of reality and rationality, structure and uniformity, postmodernism celebrates hyper-reality, imagination, deconstruction and diversity in the various forms of culture. The objectivity of outlook that was so stressed in the early 20° century modernist movement underwent a jolt during the World War II that fore grounded the irony, tragedy and disappointment underlying human rationality. People saw that too much rationality ultimately disappoints them and that human beings are fundamentally social creatures endowed with subjectivity and the power not only to reason but also to dream, and that there are things beyond material reality and rationality that human beings are interested in, that please them and that there are spaceswhere they find solution to many unanswered questions at least in their psychic sense. Hyper-reality – the seamless comingling of the real and the fictional – is one such technique that characterizes the diverse forms of culture during the post Second World War/postmodern period. The present paper is an attempt to analyze hyper-reality as a postmodern literary technique and its use in certain works of postmodern period: *Ubik* (1969) by Philip Kindred Dick, *Burning Chrome* (1982) by William Gibson and*Fury*(2001) by Salman Rushdie.

To begin with, hyper-reality is one of the fundamental concepts of postmodernism in general and postmodern literature in particular. Most often defined in negative terms, it is a condition in which the real and the fictional are so intricately mixed that no clear distinction can be made between the two. It is defined as an 'inability of consciousness to distinguish reality from a simulation of reality' (Baofu 11). On the other hand, it allows the blending of the physical reality with the virtual one as well as of human intelligence with artificial intelligence. There's no static definition of hyper-reality and the interpretations employed by theorists vary on some of the most essential terms. It in fact evolved out of the elusive aspect of reality because of the conventional definition of reality – 'the quality of being real or having an actual existence' (OED) – often lack the grounding necessary to render meaning.

The concepts of simulation (= the blending reality and representation without any clear distinction where reality stops and representations begins) and simulacrum (= image without any reality) coined by French sociologist Jean Baudrillard are most fundamental aspects of hyper-reality. In his book named *Simulacra and Simulation*(1981) Baudrillard defines hyper-reality as 'the generations by models of a real without origin or reality' and as 'a sign or representation without an original referent' (1). In most simple terms, it means 'more than real' such as the reality depicted in the Television reality shows. However, there are much deeper and richer meanings in the postmodernist readings of the term. Baudrillard views the contemporary world as one that gives way to implosions, simulations and a sense

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Insights into Customer Perception and Preference towards Facemasks during COVID-19 Pandemic: A Study upon Generation Y and Generation Z Indians

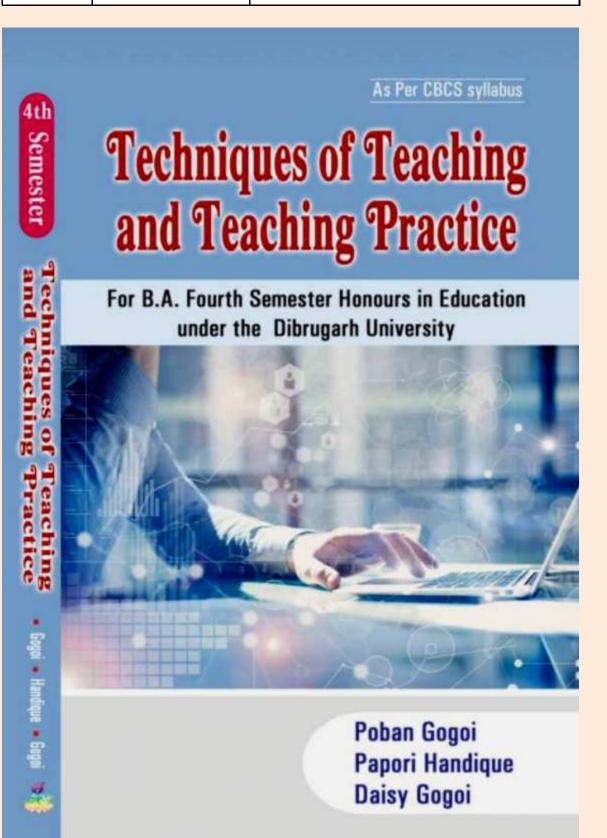

Abstract

COVID-19 has posed new threats to the world and has proved to be a catastrophic pandemic since late 2019. The cruelty of the pandemic has affected India drastically since March 2020. Doctors from across the globe have been suggesting various precautionary measures to safeguard oneself from the virus. Out of the various such measures, using facemasks is one of the most popular preventive measures. However, there tends to be a difference in opinion regarding perception towards facemasks or preference towards their quality. Intending to analyze the difference in perception and preference towards facemasks among Generation Y and Generation Z Indians, the present study provides insights into the same across the 1st and the 2nd wave of the pandemic. Further, it also ponders upon the difference in preference towards branded facemasks and locally manufactured facemasks across the two generations. Based on 800 responses collected across two phases from India, the study applied a Two-way ANOVA test to check the applicability of two proposed hypotheses after testing the reliability of the research instrument. It finds that Generation Z has a better perception towards usage of facemasks and a better preference towards locally manufacture facemasks.
