

Memorandum of Understanding Between Nature Conservation Foundation (NCF), Mysore and Digboi College

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on this 1st day of the month of August in this year 2018 at Digboi, Tinsukia-Assam (hereinafter referred to as MOU)

BETWEEN

Nature Conservation Foundation, a registered public charitable trust, under section 12A of the income Tax Act, having its registered office at 3076/5 Gokulam Park, Mysore 570002 (hereinafter referred to as NCF) represented by Dr. TR Shanker Raman, Executive Director

AND

Department of Zoology, Digboi College, having its registered office at Itabhata, Digboi, District Tinsukia, Pincode: 786171, Assam, India. (hereinafter referred to as DC) represented by Dr. Dip Saikia, Principal, Digboi College, Digboi.

WHEREAS both DC and NCF have similar objectives viz. to conduct scientific research in hornhall conservation and community engagement, thus the parties herein have decided and agreed to sign the present memorandum of understanding in order to promote collaboration between DC and NCF to achieve these common objectives through mutual understanding and effective cooperation.

ARTICLE-1

Partnership

The parties herein agree that any mutually agreed projects between DC and NCF (hereinafter called Collaborative Projects) will be run in partnership and these would include but not limited to the new projects i.e. those that the parties propose collectively, as well as ongoing projects i.e. those already initiated by one party in which the other party wishes to collaborate at a subsequent stage. The nature and extent of responsibilities shared by DC and NCF will be as per the terms mutually agreed upon by both organizations for each specific project.

ARTICLE-2

Publications, Products and Data

It is mutually agreed and understood by both ${f DC}$ and ${f NCF}$ that any publications or products resulting from collaborative projects will carry the names of both DC and NCF as collaborating institutions. Data generated from collaborative projects will be the joint property of DC and NCF. Such data would be available to either party for use, provided that both parties are given credit in any publications resulting from this data.

ARTICLE-3

Duration of This Agreement

This agreement will come into force from the 1st day of August 2018, and will remain in force till November 2020 after which it will be reviewed by DC and NCF and may be extended for a further period if mutually agreed by both parties.

ARTICLE-4

Termination

This present memorandum of understanding can be terminated by either party by giving prior 30 days' notice at the address mentioned above.

ARTICLE - 5

Force Majeure

Force majeure shall mean any unforeseeable and exceptional event affecting the present memorandum of understanding by either DC or NCF, which is beyond their control, is unforeseeable and insuperable and cannot be overcome despite their reasonable endeavours. If any of the party is subject to force majeure liable to affect the fulfillment of its obligations, it will notify the other party in writing of any "Force Majeure" event as soon as possible stating the nature, likely duration and foreseeable effects. Notwithstanding any provisions on Force Majeure provided for in the present memorandum of understanding, no party shall be considered to be in breach of its obligations under the memorandum of understanding if it has been prevented from complying by force majeure. All necessary measures shall be taken to limit damage to the minimum.

ARTICLE - 6

Jurisdiction

The parties herein agree that any dispute arising from the present mer shall be exclusively governed by the Courts having Jurisdiction at Bangalore only

TERMS OF REFERENCE

FOR COLLABORATIVE WORK BETWEEN DIGBOI COLLEGE, AND THE NATURE CONSERVATION FOUNDATION, MYSORE TO BE CONDUCTED IN 2018-2020

The Digboi College, India and the Nature Conservation Foundation (NCF), India have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for conducting research and conservation work. As part of the MoU, both parties agree to the following work to be undertaken in the financial years 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 under the project titled "Hornbill Conservation in the Dihing-Patkai WLS and adjoining areas" funded by the Whitley Fund for Nature, UK and Foundation Segré, through the Whitley-Segré Conservation Fund (WSCF) and other grants available with the Eastern Himalaya Program, Nature Conservation Foundation.

Broad Objectives

Ensure the long-term conservation of hornbills in the Dihing-Patkai and adjoining areas.

Through research and monitoring, obtain a better understanding of the population status and ecology of hornbills and other key wildlife species.

Generate local community support for hombill conservation through awareness and potential livelihood options

Specific Objectives

- Participation of the students of Digboi College for studies on hombill ecology and status in collaboration with NCF scientists/researchers.
- 2. Creating awareness regarding the importance of hornbills and other wildlife among the local communities in surrounding villages of Joypur RF, Dirok, Soraipung WLS, Pengert, Borjaan, Diglios, and Dilli-Ghat.
- 3. Developing suitable livelihood options that would generate local support for forest conservation.
- 4. Identifying hornball nests and protecting them with the local communities and the Forest Department

ACTIVITIES

NCF will commit to undertaking two training and capacity building workshops annually in science skills for students of the Zoology and Botany Department and any interested candidates from other departments.

25 students of Zoology & Botany Department, Digboi College would be selected to undertake short term field work in the Dihang Patkai and Joypur landscape to understand how to do ecological research supported by DC and NCF. Student capability/motivation and interest will be assessed based on their participation in the workshop and assignments.

Digboi College supported by NCF will conduct awareness and conservation campaigns/meetings would be conducted with targeted villages in the landscape.

Digboi College will identify youth from the local communities who would be encouraged/motivated to undertake bird/wildlife tourism as a livelihood option for income generation.

Digboi College supported by NCF will facilitate other skill-development workshops for the upliftment of local village communities surrounding protected areas.

NCF along with suitable local partners will conduct periodic monitoring of hornbill nests to ensure that they are active, safe and free of disturbance.

Digbor College and NCF will conduct discussions with local community members and the Forest Department officials to identify opportunities for hornbill conservation in the landscape.

Based on the collaboration stated in this MoU/ToR, NCF will transfer funds related to the project expenses to Rajib Rudra Tanang who will be responsible for settling advances and submission of bills to NCF.

Rajib Rudra Tariang, Assistant Professor, Digboi College will be responsible for submission of bills and accounts in a correct and timely manner.

FINANCIAL

NCF will reimburse Digboi college for project-related expenses.

NCF will provide financial assistance on year to year basis. Please refer Annexure I for the budgets for the above-mentioned financial years.

The funds will be utilized with the following terms and conditions:

- The funds should be spent as per the budget detailed in Annexure-L
- 2 Funds can only be used for the purposes stated in approved project proposal, itemized budget and supporting documents, Therefore, re-allocation of funds would require prior intimation and approval of NCF.
- 3 Any issues related to the financial matters of the project will be addressed to Dr Aparajita Datta

Permissions

There will be no violation by NCF scientists and researchers of the various acts and rules in place in Assam.

Reporting

- Digboi College will be responsible for the preparation of an annual and other scientific/narrative reports within the scope of the project objectives.
- Annual reports will be due each year by Oct 31st to Dr. Aparajita Datta, NCF who is primarily responsible for further reporting to the grant agencies – the Whitley Fund for Nature and Foundation Segré).
- Digboi College will keep NCF periodically appraised about the progress of the project.
- The final narrative reports will be submitted on completion of the project, i.e. end of Financial Year 2018-19 & 2019-20.

Output/Publications

 NCF will encourage and facilitate the publication of the information collected during this project. The authorship in the publications will follow standard scientific guidelines. Personnel working in the project from both NCF and Digboi College will have joint access to the data collected for joint peer-reviewed publications and other scientific outputs with due acknowledgement.

Effective Date, Duration and Termination of the Terms of Reference

- 1. This Terms of Reference commence from the date of receipt of the payment.
- 2. This Terms of Reference can be extended with approval of both parties.
- The agreement arrived at between the parties hereto for the utilization of intellectual property shall survive the termination of the agreement.

Amendments to the Agreement

No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be valid after date of effect, unless both parties so agree, and in writing. The modifications/amendments shall be effective from the date on which they are made, unless otherwise agreed to.

Assignment of the Agreement

The rights and/or habilities arising to any of this agreement shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

Confidentiality

Since the objective of the project is to study, document and undertake measures for conserving an endangered bird species and its habitat, and to make this knowledge freely available to academics, managers, administrators and the general populace, no confidentiality is required

ARBITRATION

In case of any dispute arising out of this agreement, the jurisdiction for arbitration will be Indian Courts, whose decision will be final and binding on both parties



Whereas DELNET has agreed to grant non-exclusive license to the Institutional Member to use DELNET's Archives and Services, Union Catalogues and other databases online, provide technical guidance in database creation and networking and deliver to the Institutional Member from time to time any computer programmes and to grant a non-exclusive license to use such programmes and their associated documents on the terms and conditions hereinafter contained:

Whereas the Institutional Member has its library located at Dighot College.

Dighot, Tinsulata, Assam. Pen 786171 and has agreed to become a member of DELNET to use DELNET archives and services at this location only and promote and share its library resources with other institutional members of DELNET.

The Institutional Member shall:

- Use the DELNET databases for furthering its own research programmes and providing information to its users and Institutional Members of DELNET.
- Use the software arranged by or through DELNET, if desired by the Institutional Methe machine owned by the Institutional Member at the above location.
- 3. Create records using international standards as adopted by DELNET from time to time (DELNET is recommending the creation of records using MARC, AACR II, the Library of Congress Subject Headings List and specialised thesauri, but libraries that have used other standards can still join DELNET and upgrade their records in due course of time).
- Contribute the records of all items created by the Institutional Member to the Central Union Catalogues, Union Lists, etc. maintained by DBLNBT. The copyright of records created by the Institutional Member in its own machine will rest in the Institutional Member, but the copyright of the Central Union Catalogues shall rest in DBLNBT.
- 5. Pay an initial registration fee of Rs.5,000 + 18% GST to DELNET towards its Corpus Fund.
- Pay Annual Membership Fee to DELNET for the use of its online resources and services at rates set by DELNET munually in advance on or before 1° April or the date of expiry of rates set by DELNET munually in advance on or before 1° April or the date of expiry of membership dies in the date of expiry of the current membership year are not received on or before the date of expiry of the current membership suspended. - Allow the use of the software/materials/database by any other person other than its own bonafide members of its library or information centre at the above location.

It is further agreed that:

- DELNET will not accept records in the Central Union Catalogues that do not have the
 essential fields as prescribed by DELNET or those that contain typographical and factual
 mistakes. The Institutional Member has agreed to create records of DELNET standard.
- The Institutional Member will have qualified manpower, a suitable computer and Internet access in their Library for the use of DELNET databases and services.
- All charges towards telecommunication, stationary, etc. arising out of the use of DELNET databases and services by the Institutional Members will be borne by the Institutional
- The Institutional Member shall not be entitled to assign, sub-license or otherwise transfer the license whether in whole or in part to any other user.
- If the Institutional Member located outside Delhi wants to invite DELNET staff to its institution for consultation or imparting training, the Institutional Member shall pay TA/DA to the DELNET staff as per DELNET norms.
- If the Institutional Member does not create standard records, cooperate with other Institutional Members of DELNET in exchanging information, DELNET shall terminate the contract with a month's notice to the Institutional Member.
- This contract may also be terminated by immediate notice in writing if DELNET or the Institutional Member has been responsible for a breach of its obligations and terms of this agreement. In such a case, the Institutional Member shall stop the use of the DELNET system facilities and databases with immediate effect and return any software/hardware provided by or through DELNET back to DELNET. All disputes between the parties shall be settled by negotiation.




