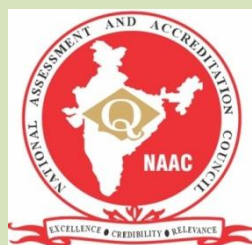

1. On 10th of November 2019, the general meeting of Parents-Teachers' Association was held at Digboi College Auditorium.

Report on ERP for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff by KBQUBE on 29th and 30th November, 2021



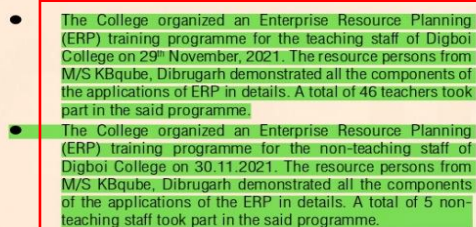
