
















































- 1. The curriculum and syllabus are need-based.


(Curriculum and its transaction)

Digboi College maintains an annual feedback mechanism for various stakeholders-Students/Teachers'/Employer/Alumni for every academic session. Accordingly, the teachers' feedback report for the academic session 2021-22 is analyzed in the form of pie charts and thereafter interpreted to undertake various courses of action.


The consolidated feedback analysis and action taken for the same are summarized as follows:

1) Are the subjects covered in the syllabus interesting for the students? 54 responses




Analysis: 72.2 % of the teachers agreed that the subjects covered in the syllabus are interesting for the students. 16.7% have a neutral opinion, whereas 7.4% strongly agreed and 3.7% strongly disagreed.

2) Are the course objectives clearly defined? 54 responses



Analysis: 70.4% of the teachers agree that the objectives of the course are clearly defined. 13% of the respondents strongly agree with the statement whereas 11% take neutral stand on the matter.


3) Is timely completion of syllabus possible for the papers taught by you in the allotted time period 54 responses






4) Does the syllabus provide enough freedom to adopt new techniques of testing and assessment of students

54 responses







7) Are the contents challenging to teach? 54 responses




Analysis: The above chart reveals that 35.2% of the teachers' agree with the contents in the curriculum being challenging to teach whereas 27.8% disagree to this statement.

8) Is the syllabus designed in a way to improve Employability Index? 54 responses






ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION (Digboi College) for the session: 2021-22




Do you feel that the college taught you some valuable lessons in character building?

80 responses















1) The syllabus ensures well-round enrichment of student's academic knowledge 1 response




Student Enrichment:The pie-chart analysis reveals that the syllabus provides a well-round enrichment in improving the academic knowledge of the students.

2) The syllabus ensures favourable teaching learning experience both for teachers and students 1 response





3) Is the course curriculum designed in a way to improve Employability index? 1 response




Employability Index: The analysis reveals an indifferent opinion on whether the course curriculum helps in improving employability index of students.

4) Rate the relevance of implementing CBCS in the course curriculum 1 response





5) Do faculty strictly follow the framed syllabus of the University? 1 response





6) Are sufficient working hours allotted for timely completion of the syllabus? 1 response






7) Are the number of book in the library sufficient to meet the requirements of the curriculum? 1 response






