


STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION IN THE INSTITUTION



TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION IN THE INSTITUTION



The feedback report is prepared on the basis of feedback form responses provided by teachers' of the college for the session: 2021-22.



ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION IN THE INSTITUTION




4) Rate the relevance of implementing CBCS in the course curriculum $_{\rm 1 \, response}$








9) How do you rate the ICT-enabled tools available for teaching? 1 response


