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### ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- a) Candidate aspiring for Admission into First Semester of FYUGP: B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com in Digboi College is required to login to the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal, Govt of Assam:

<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>

- b) Candidate has to Register himself/herself by clicking **New Registration** button putting his/her Full Name, Date of birth (as in Class X), active email ID, Mobile Number and enter a Password (with minimum 8 characters).
- c) After submission of Registration form candidate shall get a **Verification Code** through his/her registered email ID. After putting the Verification Code click on the submit button, he/she shall get a **Registration Number**.
- d) He/she has to click on the Login button and proceed with his/her Registration Number and Password.
- e) He/She has to fill the required field of Application Form with appropriate information and upload required documents.
- f) He/She has to select **Dibrugarh University** and **Digboi College** in first preference for admission into Digboi College.
- g) He/She can choose Ten major and minor subjects.
- h) He/She can choose ten colleges.
- i) After completion of the form, he/she has to click on Submit button.
- j) After successful submission of the Application form, the Candidate shall have to take a print out of the submitted form for future reference/verification.
- k) After successful submission of the Application form in Samarth e-Gov portal the Candidates have to apply Digboi College Admission Portal by login to the college website;

- l) Candidate shall be required to register in the **ONLINE ADMISSION PORTAL** by entering FULL NAME, USERNAME, PASSWORD AND A MOBILE NUMBER to login. He/ She will get an "Activation Code" in the registered Mobile Number which is to be entered for Activation.
- m) After Activation, the candidate shall be required to log in with his/ her user name and password, and to fill up the Online Application Form with correct and appropriate information.
- n) In the application form candidate has to enter his/ her Registration Number received from Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (Samarth e-Gov), Govt of Assam.

- o) The candidate shall be required to select the required **PROGRAMME** and **STREAM** from the drop down menu.
- p) The applicant can save and review the information entered before **SUBMISSION**, which can be edited on subsequent logins. However, after submission, editing of information shall not be possible.
- q) On submission of the **Online Application Form** by an applicant, an **Acknowledgement Slip and an Application Form with Unique Applicant No** shall be generated against each successful submission of the Application. **The Candidate shall have to take a print out of both for future reference/verification.**
- r) The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.
- s) Admission will be made according to the norms laid down by the Admission Committees on the basis of merit, government-prescribed reservation procedure and availability of seats.

**There shall be no alternative procedure for Application for Admission into Digboi College for the session 2023-24 and the College shall not receive any Application except through the procedure mentioned above.**

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## College Codes specifying Uniform and ID cards:

### **A. College Uniform:**

#### **1. Uniform for Girls:**

- *Muga* or *muga* coloured *Mekhela*, white *Chadar* with sky blue border and white blouse, black pump shoes, or,
- white *saree* with sky blue border and white blouse & black pump shoes, or, sky blue *kameez*, white *salwar*, white *dopatta*, black pump shoes (leggings not allowed).

#### **2. Uniform for boys:**

Black formal pants, white shirt (black belt, if used), Black shoes.

#### **3. Additional uniform for winter season:**

- For Girls: Black cardigan/ Black woollen blouse
- For Boys: Black sweater (V-neck)

### **B. Identity Card:**

Every student is issued an Identity Card valid for one year only. In case of loss, a duplicate identity card is issued based on application and payment of Rs. 100/- .

#### **NB:**

- Wearing of college uniform with ID card properly displayed during the session is mandatory for each student.
- Uniforms made of jeans are not allowed.
- No student will be allowed to enter within the college campus without his/ her identity card properly displayed.
