23. Extension Activities during the period:

Digboi College encourages students to take part in community extension activities in order to become more conscious of social issues. Women empowerment is addressed at the Digboi College adopted village (Saraipung) by training the women in sericulture practices. This initiative sought to involve rural women in the silkworm breeding and cocoon manufacturing processes as well as in the creation of Eri Silk goods. By developing livelihood skills and investing in vermi composting at zero cost, the college initiated economic development efforts through community participation. Local villagers are engaged in this practice through the operation of over ten vermin composting units, with the objective of eventually marketing the product under the brand name Patkai Vermi. Additionally, a workshop on Cost Effective Culture of Indigenous Magur to Boost Rural Economy was organized to aware the villagers on raising Magur fish, a source of livelihood. Teachers and students actively contributed in distribution of food, masks, and hand sanitizers during lockdowns and in online video awareness on maintaining COVID-19 standards, volunteering in COVID vaccination and slot booking etc. Street plays, cleanliness drives, wall painting, and the production of eco-friendly bricks from plastic bottles were initiated to raise environmental consciousness.
