Admission Policy (UG)

Digboi College (Autonomous) prepares its Admission Policy adhering to the norms and guidelines of the Govt. of Assam, the RSSCC, Assam and the resolutions of the Academic Council/Board of the College:

A) The college will strictly follow the reservation policy of the government for admission of students into the various programmes in the college.

Reservation of seats will be made separately for each department.

B) The Merit lists will be prepared based on 5(five) subjects offered in HS/10+2 level final examination.

C) The first merit list will be prepared on the basis of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences of an applicant for a programme, i.e. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preference for a Major discipline. In case sufficient number of applicants with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences are not available in a certain programme, applicants with 4th (5th and so on) preference(s) will be considered for the 1st Merit list.

D) (i) The second (and subsequent) merit list(s) will be prepared on the basis of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences of an applicant for a Major discipline if sufficient number of applicants are there in the list of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences.

(ii) If sufficient number of applicants are not there in the list of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences, applicants from the consolidated list of other preferences (4th, 5th and so on) will be selected for the 2nd Merit list.

E) Spot Admission shall be provided to fill up the vacant seats as per category in the different programmes. If sufficient number of applicants are not available for a particular category, the seats will be filled up from the remaining applicants on the last day of spot admission.

F) Admission committee will resolve any issue that may arise with due discussion.

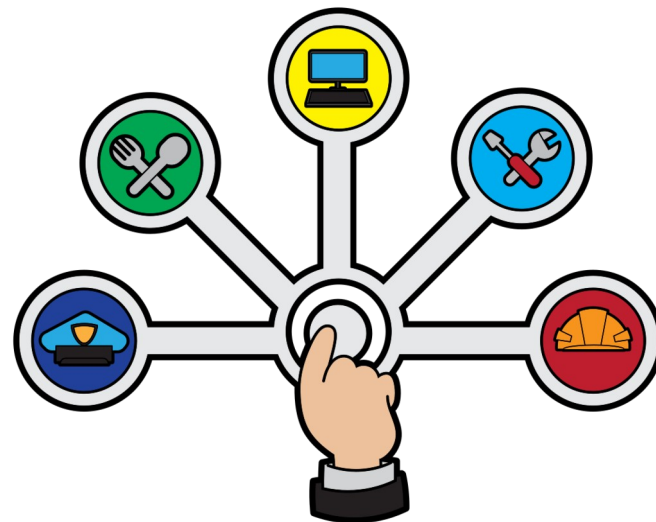

Admission Procedure for UG Programme

Steps for Samarth Portal

1. Candidate aspiring for Admission into First Semester of FYUGP: BA/ BSC/BCOM in Digboi College is required to login to the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal, Govt of Assam: assamadmission.samarth.ac.in
2. A Candidate has to Register by clicking New Registration button entering Full Name, Date of birth (as in Class X), active email ID, Mobile Number and enter a Password (with minimum 8 characters).
3. After submission of Registration form candidate shall get a Verification Code through his/her registered email ID. After entering the Verification Code click on the submit button. A Registration Number will be received through sms.
4. Click on the Login button and proceed with the Registration Number and Password.
5. Fill the required field of Application Form with appropriate information and upload required documents.
6. Candidate needs to select **Dibrugarh University** and **Digboi College** in **first preference** for admission into Digboi College.
7. Candidate can choose upto **10** (Ten) major and minor subjects.
8. A Candidate can choose any **10** (Ten) colleges.
9. After completion of the form click on Submit button.
10. After successful submission of the Application form, the Candidate shall have to take a print out of the submitted form for future reference/verification.
11. **After successful submission of the Application form in Samarth e-Gov portal the Candidates have to apply Digboi College Admission Portal by login to the college website www.digboicollege.edu.in**

Steps for Digboi College Admission Portal

1. Candidate needs to register in the ONLINE ADMISSION PORTAL by entering FULL NAME, USERNAME, PASSWORD AND A MOBILE NUMBER to login.
2. An “Activation Code” in the registered Mobile Number will be received which is to be entered for Activation of the account.
3. After Activation, log in with the username name and password, and fill up the Online Application Form with correct and appropriate information.
4. In the application form candidate has to enter the Registration Number received from Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (Samarth e-Gov), Govt of Assam.
5. The candidate shall be required to select the required PROGRAMME and STREAM from the drop down menu.
6. The applicant can save and review the information entered before SUBMISSION, which can be edited on subsequent logins. However, after submission, editing of information shall not be possible.
7. On submission of the Online Application Form by an applicant, an **Acknowledgement Slip** and an **Application Form** with Unique Applicant No shall be generated against each successful submission of the Application. The Candidate shall have to take a print out of both for future reference/verification.
8. The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.
9. Admission will be made according to the norms laid down by the Admission Committees on the basis of merit, government-prescribed reservation procedure and availability of seats.

There shall be no alternative procedure for Application for Admission into Digboi College for the session 2025-26 and the College shall not receive any Application except through the procedure mentioned above.

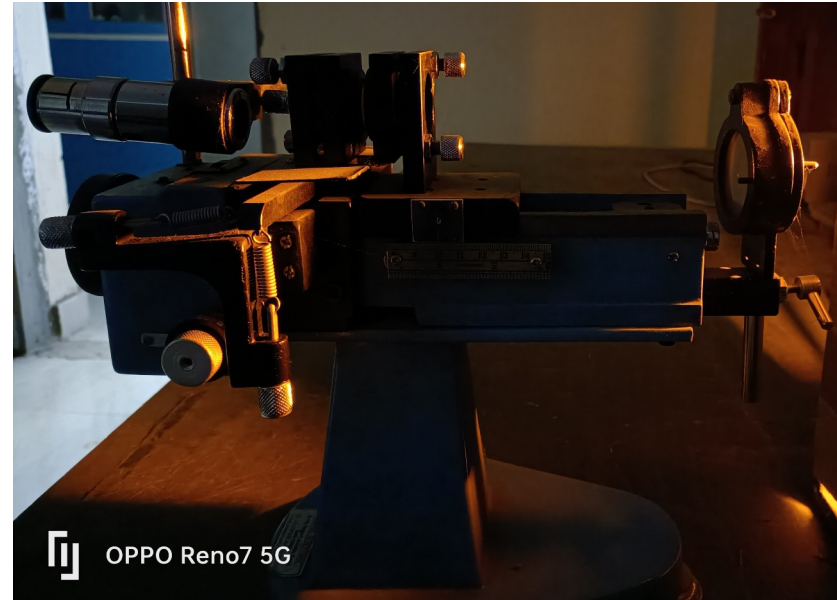
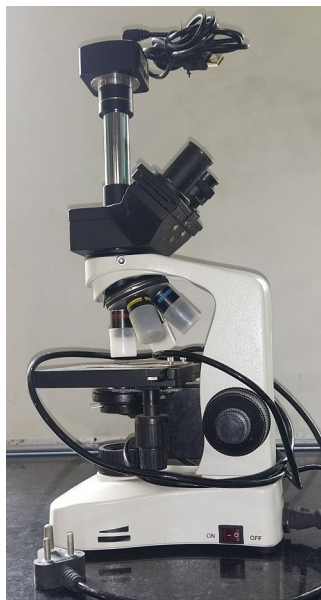
Hostel Admission

Uniform for boys:

Black formal pants, white shirt (black belt, if used), Black shoes.

Additional uniform for winter season:

For Girls: Black cardigan/ Black woollen blouse

For Boys: Black sweater (V-neck)

College Uniform for PG students:

For Boys:

White shirt with thin deep blue stripes, Black pant, Black shoes,

For winter season: Black sweater.

For Girls:

white *salwar-kameez*, blue *bandhoni dupatta* with white spots, black pump shoe,

For winter season: Black cardigan/sweater

Identity Card:

Every student is issued an Identity Card. In case of loss, a duplicate identity card is issued based on application and payment of necessary fee(s).



NB: Wearing of college uniform with ID card properly displayed during the session is mandatory for each student. Uniforms made of jeans are not allowed. No student will be allowed to enter within the college campus without identity card properly displayed.

GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTAINING DISCIPLINE

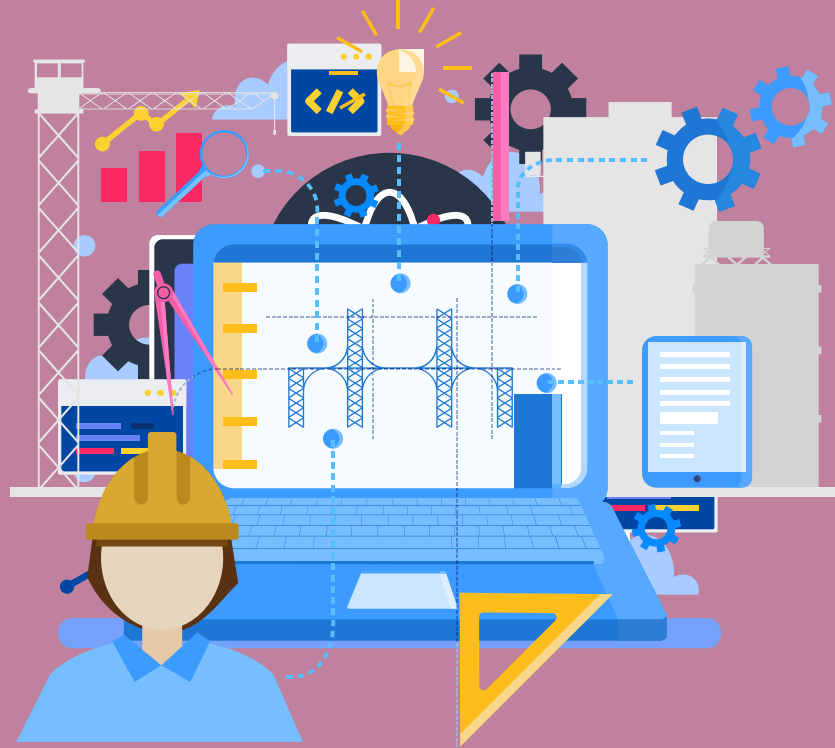
